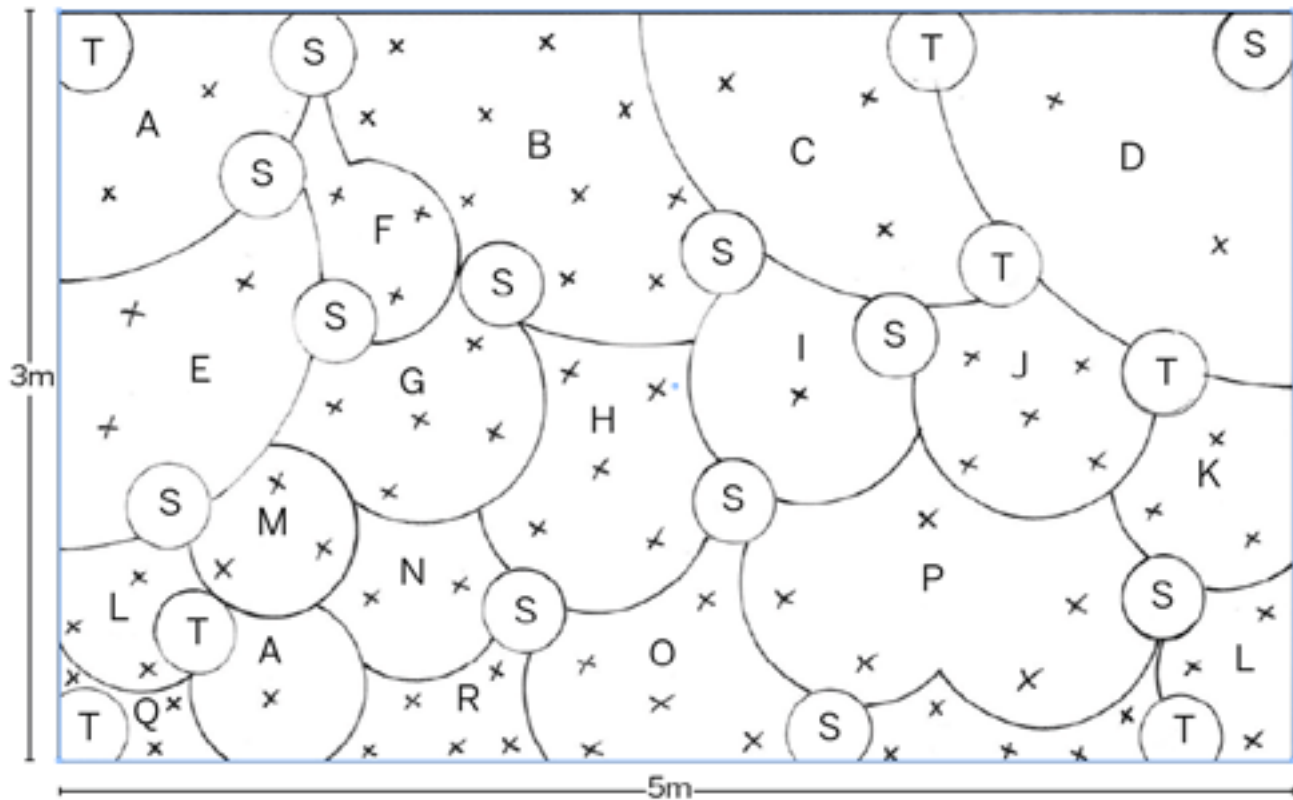

- A** *Amicia zygomeris* x3 Tender perennial grown for foliage. Yellow flowers. 2.5m.  
**B.** *Tithonia rotundifolia* 'Torch' x10 Annual with bright orange-red flowers. 2m.  
**C.** *Miscanthus sinensis* 'Silberfeder' x3 Grass with silver plumes. 2.5m. AGM.  
**D.** *Dahlia imperialis* x2 Tender perennial grown for foliage and bamboo-like stems. 4m.  
**E.** *Dahlia* 'Bishop of Llandaff' x3 Tender perennial with dark foliage and vivid red blooms. 1.5m. AGM.  
**F.** *Calamagrostis x acutiflora* 'Karl Foerster' x3 Grass with stiff, bronze feathery flowerheads. 1.8m.  
**G.** *Helenium* 'Wesergold' x5 Perennial with clear lemon yellow flowers. 1.5m. AGM.  
**H.** *Salvia* 'Indigo Spires' x5 Tender perennial, long blue flower spikes. 1.7m.  
**I.** *Rosa* 'Florence Mary Morse' x1 Vigorous Floribunda with red flowers. 2m plus.  
**J.** *Salvia uliginosa* x5 Tender perennial with sky-blue flowers. 1.5m. AGM.  
**K.** *Helenium* 'Sahin's Early Flowerer' x3 Perennial with reddish-orange flowers. 1.5m. AGM.  
**L.** *Geranium Rozanne* (= 'Gerwat') x6 Perennial, violet-blue. 0.6m. AGM.  
**M.** *Aster x frikartii* 'Mönch' x3 Perennial with lavender-blue flowers. 75cm. AGM.  
**N.** *Clematis* 'Alionushka' x2 Climber, bell-shaped mauve pink flowers. 2m. AGM.  
**O.** *Aster pyrenaicus* 'Lutetia' x5 Perennial, bright violet-blue flowers. 70cm.  
**P.** *Dahlia* 'Hillcrest Royal' x5 Tender perennial with glowing red-purple flowers. 1.5m. AGM.  
**Q.** *Miscanthus nepalensis* x3 Tender grass, gold-tinted feathers. 1.5m. AGM.  
**R.** *Cosmos sulphureus* 'Dwarf Ladybird Mixed' x10 Annual with yellow, orange or scarlet flowers. 40cm.  
**S.** *Verbena bonariensis* x12 Tender perennial, lilac-purple flowers. 1.7m. AGM.  
**T.** *Persicaria orientalis* x7 Annual with rose-red flower spikes. 1.2m.
