1 x 50g balls of Rowan Cotton Glace in Bleached (shade 726), A, Persimmon (shade 832), B, Poppy (shade 741), C, Ochre (shade 833), D and Ivy (shade 812), E Oddments of yarn for the snowman's nose, hat and scarf

Needles3mm (UK size 11) knitting needles

◆ Accessories
Small black beads
Small gold beads
Small gold and
multicoloured sequins
Small silver stars
Gold and red bugle beads
Fine red, brown and green
felt tip pens

### Tension

Tension is not important for these projects

Next row: (K2tog) twice. Next row: P2tog. Fasten off.

## **SCARF (MAKE TWO)**

Work in garter stitch for 3cm

Work in garter stitch for 3cm or 11/4in. Cast off

### **MAKING UP**

Sew in all the loose ends. Cut the six strands of white yarn approximately 14cm or  $5^{1/2}$ in long and stick them to the bottom of the card, one next to the other. Stick the body and the head onto the card. Stick the hat on top of the head. Stick the nose in the middle of the head and the scarf down the body from the neck seam. Stick two small black beads for the eyes, three beads for the mouth and three beads down the middle of the body. Cut two small strands of A approximately 3cm or 11/4 in and stick them on for the arms and six strands of A for the fingers 1cm or 1/2in long and stick them to the ends of the arms. With a fine red felt tip pen, write in small letters around three edges of the card, 'Let it Snow.' Stick small silver stars around the snowman.

### **CHRISTMAS TREE**

With E, cast on 5sts.

Row 1: K1, \*P1, K1; rep from \* to the end. Row 2: P1, \* K1, P1; rep from \* to the end.

These two rows form the rib.

Work in rib for 2cm or 1in.

Cast on 7sts, then turn. 12sts.

Next row: K12, cast on 7sts. 19sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K15, k2tog. 17sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: Sl1, K1, psso, K13, k2tog. 15sts.

Next row: Knit.

Continue decreasing as set until 7sts.

Cast on 5sts, turn. 12sts.

Next row: K12, cast on 5sts. 17sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K13, k2tog. 15sts.

Continue decreasing as set to 7 sts.

Cast on 3sts, turn. 10sts

Next row: K10, cast on 3sts. 13sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K9, k2tog. 11sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K7, k2tog. 9sts. Continue decreasing as set to 3sts.

Next row: SI1, k2tog, psso.

Fasten off.

## **BUCKET**

# SNOWMAN

**BODY** 

With A, cast on 5sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1.

Row 3: P1, M1, P5, M1, K1. Row 4: K1, M1, K7, M1, K1.

Row 5: P1, M1, P9, M1, P1.

Row 6: K1, M1, K11, M1, K1.

Row 7: Purl.

Row 8: K1, M1, K13, M1, K1.

Work five rows in st st, starting with a purl  $\,$ 

Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K11, k2tog, K1. Next row: Purl.

Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K9, k2tog, K1. Next row: P1, p2tog, P7, p2togtbl, P1.

Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K5, k2tog, K1. Next row: P1, p2tog, P3, p2togtbl, P1. Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K1, k2tog, K1.

Cast off the remaining 5sts.

#### **HEAD**

With A, cast on 3sts. Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1.

Row 3: P1, M1, P3, M1, K1.

Row 4: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1.

Row 5: P1, M1, P7, M1, K1.

Row 6: K1, M1, K9, M1, K1.

Work five rows in stocking stitch, beginning with a purl row.

Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K7, k2tog, K1.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K1, sl1, K1, psso, K5, k2tog, K1.

Next row: P1, p2tog, P3, p2togtbl, P1.

Cast off the remaining 7sts.

### **NOSE**

With B, cast on 6sts.

# HAT

With C, cast on 10sts.

Row 1: \*K1, P1; rep from \* to the end. Repeat the last row three times more.

Next row: Knit. Next row: Purl.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, knit to the last 2sts, k2tog.

Next row: Purl.

Repeat the last two rows until 4sts.



With C, cast on 9sts. Knit three rows.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K5, k2tog. 7sts. Next row: Knit to the end of the row. Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K3, k2tog.

Knit two rows. Cast off.

### **MAKING UP**

Sew in all the loose ends. Stick the tree and bucket onto the front of the card. Stick the multi-coloured sequins over the tree and the large gold sequin to the top of the tree. Stick small gold beads onto the card around the tree. With a green pen, write across the bottom and halfway up the sides, 'Merry Christmas'.

## **BAUBLES**

With C, cast on 3sts.

Purl one row.

Next row: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1. 5sts.

Next row: P1, M1, P3, M1, K1. 7sts.

Next row: K1, M1, K5, M1, K1. 9sts.

Next row: P1, M1, P7, M1, P1. 11sts.

Change to B.

Work four rows in st st.

Change to C.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K7, k2tog.

Next row: P2tog, P5, p2togtbl.

Next row: Sl1, K1, psso, K3, k2tog. 5sts.

Next row: P2tog, P1, p2togtbl. 3sts.

Next row: SI1, k2tog, psso.

Fasten off leaving an end approximately

3cm or 11/4in long.

Make another round bauble in B.

### **OVAL BAUBLE**

With D, cast on 2sts.

Purl one row.

Next row: K1, M1, K1. 3sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K1, M1, K1, M1, K1. 5sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K1, M1, K3, M1, K1. 7sts.

Next row: Purl.

Change to C and knit one row.

Change to D and work three rows in st st.

Change to C and knit one row. Change to D and purl one row.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K3, k2tog. 5sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: SI1, K1, psso, K1, k2tog. 3sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: SI1, k2tog, psso.

Fasten off, leaving an end approximately

3cm or 11/4in long.

### **MAKING UP**

Sew in all of the loose yarn ends. On the two-round bauble, sew rows of small beads across the front. Stick the three baubles to the front of the card. Stick seven gold bugle beads into a star shape on the front of the card three times. Now stick gold sequins to the front of the card around the baubles. Then, using a brown pen, write 'Merry Christmas' around the edge of the card on all four sides.
