You will need...

Cascade 220
Purple (8901)
A 4½mm circular needle
Three buttons

Tension

Yarn used knits as aran to this tension:

20 sts and 28 rows to measure 4x4in (10x10cm) over stitch pattern using 4½mm needles



Sizing colour key

So you can re-use this pattern, we've colour-coded the sizing instructions. Simply follow our colour-coded measurements and you're off.

YARN

CASCADE 220 100g/201m			
Purple (8901)	1	1	1

Using just 100g of aran-weight yarn, this hat is ideal if you need to knit a gift in a hurry, or if you want a pretty hat for yourself. Cascade 220 is 100% Peruvian highland wool, so it's very warm and will hold its shape well.

If you're a new knitter, you should be able to knit this hat. Working in the round on a circular needle is quite a simple process, and you'll always have the right side of the cables facing you, which should make it easy to spot if you make a mistake. "You might want to use a stitch marker to show where the round begins," advises designer Kirstie McLeod. Experienced knitters will whip the hat up in no time.

Start knitting here

Cast on 90 (100: 110) sts using 4½mm circular needle, join into the round.

Round 1 *K1, P1; repeat from * to end of round. Repeat round 1 nine more times, 10 rounds in total.

CABLE PATTERN

Round 1-5 *K2, P2, K4, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

Round 6 *K2, P2, C4B, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

These 6 rounds form the pattern. Repeat them 4 times, ending with a round 6. [5 repeats]

1st dec round *K2, p2tog, K4, P2; rep from * to end of round. [81 (90: 99) sts]

Next round *K2, P1, K4, P2; repeat from * to end of round.

2nd dec round *K2, P1, K4, p2tog; rep from * to end of round. [72 (80: 88) sts]

Next round *K2, P1, K4, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

3rd dec round *K2tog, P1, K4, P1; rep from * to end of round. [63 (70: 77) sts]

Next round *K1, P1, C4, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

4th dec round *K2, P1, k2tog, K2, p2tog; rep from * to end of round. [54 (60: 66) sts]

Next round *K1, P1, K3, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

5th dec round *K1, P1, K1, k2tog, P1; rep from *



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to end of round. [45 (50: 55) sts]

Next round *K1, P1, K2, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

6th dec round *K1, P1, k2tog, P1; rep from * to end of round. [36 (40: 44) sts]

Next round *K1, P1, K1, P1; repeat from * to end of round.

7th dec round *K2tog, K2; rep from * to end of round. [27 (30: 33) sts]

Next round Knit to end of round.

8th dec round *K2tog, K1; rep from * to end of round. [18 (20: 22) sts]

Next round Knit to end of round.

9th dec round *K2tog; rep from * to end of round. [9 (10: 11) sts]

Thread yarn through stitches and secure. Weave in all loose ends, hand wash and reshape while wet. Sew on buttons if desired.

The decreases are placed in such a way that they don't disrupt the pattern.
