

# YOUR KNIT TODAY FREE GIFT

## MATERIALS

- Yarn  
Wool and the Gang Crazy  
Sexy Wool  
2 balls in shade TV Static (1 ball  
for hat and 1 ball for cowl)
- Needles  
1 set of 12mm (US 17) 40cm or  
60cm circular knitting needles

## TENSION

7 sts and 10 rows using 12mm  
needles to 10cm or 4in in st st

## YARN DETAILS

- Wool and the Gang  
Crazy Sexy Wool  
Super chunky  
100% wool  
80m/87yds per 200g ball  
woolandthegang.com  
£15.50

## SIZES

- Hat** To fit average adult.
- Cowl** Approx. 64cm circumference

## ABBREVIATIONS

- k** knit
- p** purl
- k2togtbl** knit two sts together  
through the back loops
- ssk** slip one stitch knitwise, return  
to left needle and k2togtbl
- yo** yarnover
- brp** Purl the next st with its  
corresponding yarnover
- brk** Knit the next stitch with its  
corresponding yo
- yf sl1yo** bring yarn forward  
between needles to front of work,  
slip next stitch purl-wise, then  
bring the yarn over needle and  
across slipped stitch to back of  
work (used on rounds when  
working brk)
- sl1yof** leave the working yarn in  
front, slip next stitch purl-wise,  
then bring the yarn over and across  
the stitch, then back to the front of  
work (used on rounds when  
working brp)

NOTE: When weaving in ends,  
twist yarn tails several times first to  
prevent breakages.



# BIG IS BEAUTIFUL

This super chunky set would make a great last  
minute present. Or knit it as a treat for yourself!

**G**ift knitting often ends in a festive  
rush of casting off and weaving  
in ends. Happily, you can knit  
this hat and cowl in an evening each,  
leaving plenty of time for celebrating!

## RIB STITCH HAT

Using 12mm circular needles and thumb  
method cast on 36 sts and join to work  
in the round, being careful not to twist  
stitches.

**Round 1:** (K1, p1) 18 times.

Work 31 more rounds as set.

**Round 33:** (Ssk) 18 times. 18 sts

Break yarn, leaving a long tail.

Thread tail through rem sts and pull  
tight, remembering to twist yarn tail  
beforehand.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Make a large pom pom with remaining  
yarn, using a finer oddment of yarn to tie  
around centre of pom pom. Trim to  
shape and fasten to top of hat.  
Wear with brim turned back.

## BRIOCHE STITCH COWL

Using 12mm circular needles and thumb  
method cast on 32 sts and join to work  
in the round, being careful not to  
twist stitches. At first this will seem too  
narrow but brioche stitch is very stretchy.

**Set up round:** (K1, yf sl1yo) to end  
of round.

**Round 1:** (yf sl1yo, brk) to end of round.

**Round 2:** (brp, sl1yof) to end of round.

Repeat the last two rounds until you  
have approx 4m of yarn left.

Cast off loosely and weave in ends.
