FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING

This book contains forty Foundation Paper Piecing pages for you to use to sew blocks. Each page will make one block. Simply tear out a page to get started!

There are four block designs: two Log Cabin Blocks and two Economy Blocks. Each block has a finished size of 6in square (6½in before being sewn into a quilt), so you can easily use all four designs together in one project.

LOG CABINS

These blocks are great for using up strips from your stash, from approx 1in – 2in wide. Mix bold prints with low volume fabrics to create plenty of contrast.

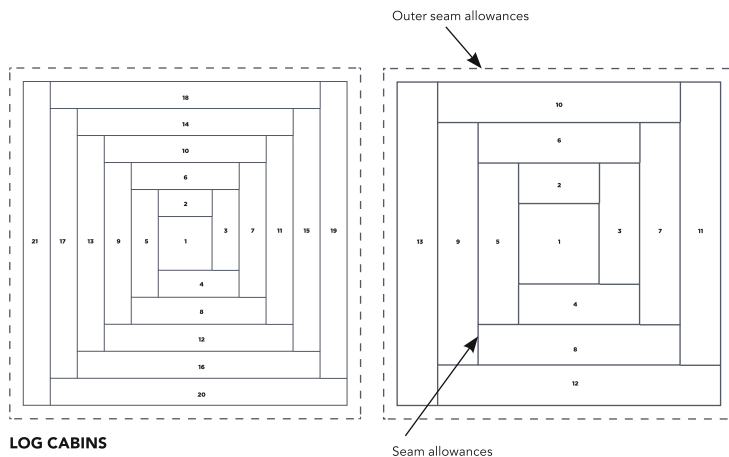
ECONOMY BLOCKS

Use squares cut on the diagonal to quickly cut triangles for the Economy blocks, ranging in sizes from 1¾in – 3¾in. Use four matching triangles in each round, or go wild with a mix of prints!

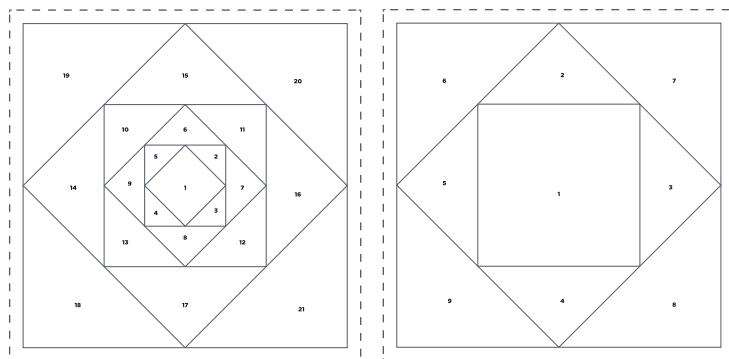
The solid printed lines mark the seams and the outer dashed line marks the seam allowance around the edge of the block. When you are sewing, you will sew on the printed lines, with the template facing you. The fabric you will sew onto will be right side down, with its wrong side against the back of the template. The finished sewn block will be a reverse image of the template.

TOP TIP

If you want to use a colour scheme, use coloured pencils to mark different areas of the block before you begin sewing to help you visualize.
