

Frog Granny Square crochet pattern by @fanaticalfibres



You will need

- Any Aran-weight yarn in green, blue, black, and pink
- A 4mm (US G/6) hook
- 2 safety eyes, 7mm

Tension

Tension is not critical for this project

Abbreviations

hdtr (half double treble) Yrh twice, insert hook in st indicated, yrh and pull up a loop, yrh and pull through 2 loops on hook, yrh and pull through all rem loops on hook

Notes

The frog's body and head is worked first in rounds. The remainder of the square is worked around this piece. The frog's eyes, legs and arms are made separately and sewn in place at the end.

Frog Granny Square pattern

Using **green**, make a [crochet magic loop](#).

Round 1 (RS) Ch2 (does not count as st throughout), 15tr in loop, ss to top of beg tr. [15 sts]

Round 2 (RS) Ch2, 2tr in each st around, ss to top of beg tr. [30 sts]

Round 3 (Working in fl only) Ch1 (does not count as st), *2dc in next st, htr in next st, 2tr in next st, tr in next st, 2hdtr in next st, hdtr in next st, 2dtr in next st, dtr in next st, 2hdtr in next st, 2tr in next st, tr in next st, 2htr in next st, dc in next st, 2dc in next st, dc in next st; rep from * once more, ss to beg dc. [46 sts]

Fasten off.

Join **blue** in first unworked bl from Round 2.

Round 4 (Working in unused bl from Round 2) Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), tr in st at base of ch-3. tr in next 3 sts, ch2, tr in next 8 sts, ch2, tr in next 3 sts, 2tr in next st, tr in next 3 sts, ch2, tr in next 8 sts, ch2, tr in next 3 sts, ss to top of beg ch-3. [32 sts, 4 ch-2 sps]

Round 5 Ch3, *tr in each st to ch-2 sp, (2tr ch2, 2tr) in ch-sp, tr in next 4 sts, tr in next st and through the central dtr from Round 3, tr in each st to ch-2 sp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in ch-sp; rep from * once more, tr in each st to end, ss to top of beg ch-3. [48 sts, 4 ch-2 sps]



Round 6 Ch3, *tr in each st to ch-3 sp, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in ch-sp; rep from * around, ss to top of beg ch-3. [60 sts, 4 ch-2 sps]

Round 7 Ch4 (counts as tr, ch1), skip next st, (tr in next st, ch1, skip 1 st) across to ch-2 sp, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in ch-sp, (tr in next st, ch1, skip 1 st) across to next corner, rep from * around to end, ss to third ch of beg ch-4. [48 tr, 4 ch-2 sps, 28 ch-1 sps]

Round 8 Ch1, *dc in each st and ch-1 sp across to ch-2 sp, 5dc in ch-2 sp; rep from * around to end, ss to beg dc. [96 sts]

Eyes (make 2)

Using **green**, make a [crochet magic loop](#).

Round 1 (RS) Ch1, 10dc in loop, ss to beg dc.

Fasten off.

Secure the safety eyes through the centre of each eye.

Sew the Eyes to the top of the frog.

Arms (make 2)

Using **green**, ch12. Ss in second ch from hook and each ch to end.

Fasten off.

Sew the Arms either side of the frog.

Legs (make 2)

Using **green**, ch9. Ss in second ch from hook and each ch to end.

Fasten off.

Sew the Legs either side of the frog.

To finish



Using **black**, embroider the mouth over the top of Round 2.

Using **pink**, embroider French knots for the cheeks.

Weave in all ends.
