



### Free Crochet Granny Square Pattern by Jessica Carey (the.hook.nook)

We've converted Jessica's crochet square patterns into UK terms, but if you would like the patterns in US terms you can find them on her blog here.

#### You will need:

- The Hook Nook Small Stuff, Foggy Morning (or alternative Dk yarn)
- size H/5mm hook

Ch2.

**Round 1 (RS)** 3tr in second ch from hook, ch2, (3tr in same ch, ch2) 3 times, ss to beg dc. [12 sts, 4 ch-2 sps]

**Round 2 (RS)** Ss to ch-2 sp, ch1 (does not count as a st throughout), (3tr, ch3, 3tr, ch1) in each ch-2 sp around, ss to top of beg tr. [24 sts, 4 ch-3 sps, 4 ch-1 sps]

**Round 3** Ss into ch-3 sp, ch1, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in ch-3 sp, ch1, 3tr in ch-1 sp, ch1; rep from \* three times more, ss to top of beg tr. [36 sts, 4 ch-3 sps, 8 ch-1 sps]

**Round 4** Ss into ch-3 sp, ch1, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in ch-3 sp, ch1, (3tr, ch1) in each ch-1 sp to corner; rep from \* three times more, ss to top of beg tr. [48 sts, 4 ch-3 sps, 12 ch-1 sps]





Repeat Round 4 to required size.

**Next Round** Ch1, dc in each st and ch-1 sp to next ch-3 corner sp, 5dc in ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ss to top of beg dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Free Circle Centre Crochet Granny Square Pattern by Jessica Carey (the.hook.nook)



#### You will need:

- The Hook Nook Main Squeeze, Multigrain (or alternative Aran yarn) -
- size I/5.5mm hook

Ch2.

Round 1 (RS) 8htr in second ch from hook, ss to top of beg htr. [8 sts]

Round 2 Ch1 (does not count as a st throughout), 2htr in each st around, ss to top of beg htr. [16 sts]

Round 3 Ch1, (2htr in next st, htr in next st) 8 times, ss to top of beg htr. [24 sts]

Round 4 Ch1, (2htr in next st, htr in next 2 sts) 8 times, ss to top of beg htr. [32 sts]





**Round 5** Ch1, \*dc in next 3 sts, htr in next st, tr in next st, ch3, skip 1 st, tr in next st, htr in next st; rep from \* three times more, ss to top of beg dc. [28 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

**Round 6** Ch1, \*htr in each st to ch-3 sp, (2htr, ch3, 2htr) in ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ss to top of beg htr. [44 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

Round 7 Ch1, \*dc in each st to ch-3 sp, 5dc in ch-3 sp; rep from \* around, ss to top of beg dc. [64 sts]

Fasten off and weave in ends.

# Free Flower Crochet Granny Square Pattern by Jessica Carey (the.hook.nook)



#### You will need:

- The Hook Nook Yummy/Luxe/Tweed (or alternative Chunky yarn) -
- Little Black Dress (Color A)
- Latte Foam (Color B)
- o Cookies & Cream (Color C)
- size J/6mm hook

Using Yarn A, ch2.





**Round 1 (RS)** 8htr in second ch from hook, ss to top of beg htr. [8 sts]

**Round 2** Ch1 (does not count as a st throughout), (ss, 3htr, ss) in each st around, ss into beg ss, turn. [24 sts]

With WS facing, join Yarn B in fl of first ss on any petal.

**Round 3 (WS)** \*Ch3, skip 3 sts, ss in fl of next ss on same petal, ss in fl of next ss on next petal; rep from \* seven times more, ss in base of beg ch-3, turn. [8 ch-3 sps]

**Round 4 (RS)** Ch1, ss into ch-3 sp, (5tr, ss) in same sp, (ss, 5tr, ss) in next 7 ch-3 sps, ss in beg ss, turn. [40 sts]

Join **Yarn C** around post of centre tr of any 5-tr group.

**Round 5** \*Ch5, ss around centre tr of next 5-tr group; rep from \* seven times more, ss around same post as begin ss, turn. [8 ch-5 sps]

**Round 6** Ch1, 3dc in each ch-5 sp around, ss to beg dc, do not turn. [24 sts]

**Round 7** Ch2 (does not count as a st), \*tr in next st, htr in next st, dc in next 2 sts, htr in next st, tr in next st, ch3; rep from \* three times more, ss to top of beg tr. [24 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

**Rounds 8-9** Ch1, \*htr in each st to ch-3 sp, (htr, ch3, htr) in ch-sp; rep from \* around, ss to top of beg htr. [40 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

Join **Yarn A** in any ch-3 sp.

**Round 10** As Round 8. [48 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

**Round 11** Ch1, \*dc in next 4 sts, ch5, ss around post of tr directly below from Round 4, ch5, skip 4 sts on current round, dc in next 4 sts, 5dc in ch-3 sp; rep from \* three times more, ss to beg dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
