SKILL LEVEL Easy

YOU WILL NEED

- Any DK yarn in 3 colours
- A 3 mm (US C/2 or D/3) hook


## MEASUREMENTS

## Square measures approx $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}(4 \times 4 i n)$

NOTES

Square is worked in rounds with RS facing throughout. Colours are referred to as Yarns A-C.

## Daisy Daisy Granny Square Pattern

Using Yarn A, make a crochet magic loop.

Round 1 (RS) Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), 11tr into loop, ss to top of beg ch-3. [12 sts] Fasten off. Join Yarn B around BP of any st.

Round 2 (RS) Ch3, BPtr around same st, 2BPtr around each st around, ss to top of beg ch-3. [24 sts] Fasten off.

Join Yarn C in sp between beg ch-3 and first tr of Round 2.

Round 3 Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), dc in the same sp, *ch2, skip 2 sts, dc in sp between 2 tr; rep from * 10 times more, ch2, ss to beg dc. [12 sts, 12 ch-2 sps]

Round 4 Ss to first ch-2 sp, ch3, (2tr, ch3, 3tr) in the same sp, *2htr in the next 2 ch-2 sps, (3tr, ch3, $3 t r)$ in the next ch2-sp; rep from * twice more, 2 htr in the next 2 ch-2 sps, ss to top of beg ch-3. [40 sts, 4 ch-3 sps] Fasten off.

Join Yarn B in any ch-3 sp.

Round 5 Ch1, *(dc, ch3, dc) in ch-3 sp, ch3, skip 3 sts, dc in sp before next htr, ch3, skip 4 htr, dc in sp before next tr, ch3, skip 3 sts; rep from * 3 times more, ss to beg dc. [16 sts, 16 ch-3 sps] Fasten off.

Join Yarn A in any ch-3 corner sp.

Round 6 Ch3, ( 2 tr , ch3, 3tr) in same sp, *3tr in each ch-sp to next corner**, (3tr, ch3, 3tr) in corner ch-sp; rep from ${ }^{*} 3$ times more ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, ss to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

Join Yarn C in any ch-3 sp.

Round 7 Ch1, *(dc, ch1, dc) in corner sp, dc in each to next corner; rep from * 3 times more, ss to beg dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends

Mitred Rainbow Granny Square by Becky Skuse


SKILL LEVEL Easy

YOU WILL NEED

- Any DK yarn in dark pink, lilac, blue, teal, green, yellow, orange, red and grey
- A 4mm (US G/6) hook


## MEASUREMENTS

Square measures approx $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}(4 \times 4 \mathrm{in})$

NOTES

Square is worked in rows. Change colour on the final yrh on final st of row and work over the tails to reduce the number of ends you need to weave in.

Mitred Rainbow Granny Square Pattern

Using pink, ch4 and ss to first ch to form a loop.

Row 1 (RS) Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), (tr, dtr, 2tr) in loop, turn. [5 sts]

Change to lilac.

Row 2 Ch3, tr in next tr, (2tr, dtr, 2tr) in dtr, tr in next 2 tr, turn. [9 sts]

Change to blue.

Row 3 Ch3, tr in each tr to corner dtr, (2tr, dtr, 2tr) in dtr, tr in each tr to end, turn. [13 sts] Change to teal.

Rows 4-8 As Row 3, using green, yellow, orange and red in order. [33 sts] Fasten off.

## EDGING

With RS facing, join grey in dtr.

Round 1 (RS) Ch1, 3dc in dtr, dc in each st to next corner, (3dc in corner, 2dc in each rowend to next corner) twice, 3 dc in corner, dc in each st to end, ss to beg dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
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## HAP-Pea Granny Square by Sarah-Jane Hicks



SKILL LEVEL Easy

YOU WILL NEED

- Any DK yarn in green, light pink and dark pink
- A 3.5mm (US E/4) hook
- Black stranded cotton

MEASUREMENTS

Square measures approx $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}(4 \times 4 i n)$

NOTES

Square is worked in rounds with RS facing throughout.

HAP-PEA Granny Square Pattern

Using green, ch3.

Round 1 (RS) 8htr in last ch from hook, ss to top of beg ch-3. [9 htr]

Round 2 (RS) Ch2, htr in same st, 2 htr in each st around, ss to top of beg ch-2. [18 tr]

Round 3 Ch2, 2 htr in next st, (htr in next st, $2 h t r$ in next st) 8 times, ss to top of beg ch-2. [27 $\mathrm{htr}]$

Round 4 Ch2, htr in next st, 2 htr in next st, (htr in next 2 sts, 2 htr in next st) 8 times, ss to top of beg ch-2. [36 htr] Fasten off.

Join light pink in bl of any st.

Round 5 (Working in bl throughout), Ch3 (counts as first tr), tr in next 3 sts, *(2dtr, ch2, 2 dtr ) in next st, tr in next 8 sts; rep from * 3 times more omitting final 4 sts on last rep, ss to top of beg ch-3. [48 sts, 4 ch-2 sps]

Round 6 Ch2, *htr in each st to ch-2 sp, ( 2 htr, ch2, 2 htr ) in ch-sp; rep from * around, ss to top of beg ch-2. [64 sts, 4 ch-2 sps] Fasten off.

Join dark pink in any st.

Round 7 Ch1 (does not count as st), *dc in each st to ch-2 sp, (dc, ch2, dc) in ch-sp; rep from * around, ss to beg dc. Fasten off.

## TO FINISH

Using black stranded cotton, embroider the eyes and mouth. Weave in all ends.

## YOU WILL NEED

- Any DK yarn in orange, white, yellow, black and green
- A 4 mm (US G/6) hook
- A 3 mm (US C/2 or D/3) hook


## MEASUREMENTS

Square measures approx $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}(4 \times 4 \mathrm{in})$

NOTES

Square is worked in rounds. The Ears, Eyes and Snout are made separately and sewn in place at the end.

## Tigerriffic Granny Square Pattern

## SQUARE

Using a 4 mm hook and orange, ch4.
Round 1 11tr into last ch from hook, ss to top of beg ch-4. [12 sts]

Round 2 Ch3 (counts as tr throughout), 2 tr in next 11 sts, tr in same st as beg ch-3, ss to top of beg ch-3. [24 sts] Change to green.

Round 3 Ch2 (counts as htr), (htr, ch3, 2htr) in st at base of ch-2, *htr in next st, dc in next 3 sts, htr in next st**, (2htr, ch3, 2htr) in next st; rep from * 3 times more ending last rep at ${ }^{* *}$, ss to top of beg ch-2. [36 sts, 4 ch-3 sps]

Round 4 Ch2, *htr in each st to ch-3 sp, (2htr, ch2, 2htr) in ch-3 sp; rep from * around, ss to top of beg ch-2. [52 sts, 4 ch-2 sps] Fasten off.

## EARS (MAKE 2)

Using a 3 mm hook and orange, ch4.

Row 1 (RS) 6tr in last ch from hook. [6 sts]

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

## SNOUT

Using a 3 mm hook and white, ch4.

Round 1 (RS) 11tr in last ch from hook, ss to top of beg ch-4. [12 sts]

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

EYES (MAKE 2)

Using a 3mm hook and yellow, ch2.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into second ch from hook, ss to beg dc. [6 sts]

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

## TO FINISH

Using the images as a guide, sew the Ears, Eyes and Snout onto the Square.

Using black, embroider the pupils onto the Eyes, the mouth and nose onto the Snout and stripes around the edges of the face. Weave in all ends.
