

HOW TO MAKE AN AMIGURUMI DOLL > E

MATERIALS

- Schachenmayr Catania, 100% mercerised cotton, 50g/125m per ball; 1 ball each in
- Sunkissed (00437) (Yarn A), Reseda (00402) (Yarn B), Marsalarot (00396) (Yarn C), Zimt (00383) (Yarn D), Bast (00257) (Yarn E), Kaffee (00162) (Yarn F) and Vanille (00403) (Yarn G)
- Black and white embroidery thread
- 2.5mm (UK 12, US C/2) crochet hook
- Soft toy stuffing ■ Stitch marker (or scrap
- Yarn needle

TENSION

yarn)

Tension is not too important, just aim for a dense neat stitch so the stuffing does not show

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

st(s) stitch(es) **ch** chain dc double crochet ws waistcoat st - insert hook into the middle of the 'v' of the previous round's dc st instead of inserting the hook below the two loops of the dc st htr half treble **tr** treble

ss slip stitch **BLO** work st through back loop only

inc increase by working 2dc in next st invdec invisible decrease - insert hook into the front

loop of the next st and then under both loops of the following st, pull yarn through (2 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through

last two loops on the hook magic ring hold yarn in your hand and wrap

working yarn around forefinger twice to create ring, slip ring off your finger and insert hook to pick up first st, ch1, then work the necessary sts for round 1 and close the ring tightly by pulling the loose end

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES X-shaped dc using this method instead of the traditional V-shaped double crochet, the stitches will be tighter, and the items will be slightly smaller. This project uses the X-shaped dc, but use the traditional method if you prefer. To work the stitch, insert the hook under both loops of the stitch below, place yarn under the hook (in other words hook the yarn from above), pull through the

loop and finish the dc as you normally would. Tapestry crochet this technique uses two or

more colours in the same round. You change the colours within the rounds, and carry the additional yarn along with you, and work over it as you crochet. Changing colours happens on the last step of the previous stitch. When you have two loops of Yarn X on your hook, yarn over with Yarn Y, and pull through all of the loops on the hook to finish the stitch. The upper part of the doll's dress and

Get your wellies on and follow Orsi's beautiful amigurumi doll back into the garden as the

weather starts to warm up. Tweak the colours to make her in the likeness of a mum figure in your life for a personal Mother's Day gift.

Instructions

This pattern uses concise crochet terms, for example 6dc means work 1dc in each of next 6 sts. The doll, her accessories and the watering can are made in continuous rounds unless otherwise instructed. Do not join at the end of each round but continue to the next round. When working in rounds, use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to indicate the start of each round and move it up as you work. The doll is made from the feet upwards, with the legs, body and head all in one piece.

Leg 1 using Yarn A, start with a

magic ring

Round 1 6dc in magic ring, pull ring tight [6dc]

Round 2 inc 6 times [12dc] Rounds 3-31 1dc into each st around

Fasten off, and stuff the leg Count 7 sts from the end of the last round and place a stitch marker into the 7th st, this is where you will join Leg 2

Leg 2 work as for Leg 1 but do not fasten off at the end of Round 31. instead continue with the body

Round 1 ch5, 1dc in marked st of Leg 1, 11dc in Leg 1, 5dc into the front loops of ch5 (between the legs), 12dc in Leg 2, 5dc into the unused loops of ch5 (between the legs), replace the stitch marker [34dc]

Round 2 (inc, 10dc, inc, 5dc) 2 times [38dc]

Round 3 (inc, 12dc, inc, 5dc) 2 times [42dc]

Rounds 4-11 1dc in each st around Change to Yarn B

Round 12 1dc in each st around Round 13 work this round in BLO, (5dc, invdec) 6 times [36dc] Continue crocheting the top part of the dress using the tapestry

Round 14 (3dc, change to Yarn C, 1dc, change to yarn B) Fasten off Yarn C

Round 15 1dc in each st around Round 16 (4dc, invdec) 6 times

Round 17 (2dc, change to Yarn D, 1dc, change to Yarn B) 10 times [30dc]

Fasten off Yarn D

crochet technique

Round 18 1dc in each st around Round 19 (3dc, invdec) 6 times [24dc]


Start to stuff the body Round 20 (2dc, change to Yarn E,

1dc, change to Yarn B) 8 times Fasten off Yarn E Round 21 1dc in each st around

Round 22 (2dc, invdec) 6 times

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Change to Yarn A, stuff the body Round 23 work this round in BLO, 1dc in each st around Do not fasten off, continue with the head

Round 1 inc 18 times [36dc] **Round 2** (5dc, inc) 6 times [42dc] **Round 3** 3dc, inc, (6dc, inc) 5 times, 3dc [48dc]

Round 4 (7dc, inc) 6 times [54dc] Round 5 4dc, inc, (8dc, inc) 5 times, 4dc [60dc]

Rounds 6-18 1dc in each st around Round 19 (8dc. invdec) 6 times [54dc]

Round 20 (7dc, invdec) 6 times

[48dc] Round 21 (6dc, invdec) 6 times

[42dc] Round 22 (5dc, invdec) 6 times

[36dc]

Round 23 (4dc, invdec) 6 times [30dc]

Round 24 (3dc, invdec) 6 times [24dc]

Round 25 (2dc, invdec) 6 times [18dc]

Round 26 (1dc, invdec) 6 times

[12dc] Stuff the head

Round 27 invdec 6 times [6dc] Fasten off and leave a long tail. Finish stuffing the head firmly. Using a yarn needle close the small hole by inserting the needle through the back loops of the 6 sts, pull the tail to close the hole

Skirt

Weave in the end

Turn the doll upside down, and with Yarn B join with a ss to a front loop of Round 12 of the body, at

the midd e of the back of the doll. Work in joined rounds, join with a ss to the 1st dc of the round at the end of each round. Ch1 at the beginning of the rounds doesn't count as a dc. For the skirt, use the normal (V-shaped) dc instead of the X-shaped dc.

Round 1 ch1, inc in each st around, ss to 1st dc to join [84dc] Round 2 1dc in each st around, ss

to 1st dc to join Change to Yarn D. From now on

work using ws Round 3 ch1, 1ws in each st

around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn D Rounds 4-6 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn E

Round 7 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn E Rounds 8-10 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join

Change to Yarn C Round 11 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join

Rounds 12-14 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn D

Round 15 ch1. 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join

Rounds 16-18 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn E

Round 19 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Rounds 20-22 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join Change to Yarn C

Round 23 ch1. 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join

Rounds 24-26 ch1, 1ws in each st around, ss to 1st ws to join

Change to Yarn D, fasten off Yarn B Round 27 {(1dc, 1tr, 1dc) in next st, 1ss in each of next 2 sts} 28 times

Fasten off, and weave in the end

Embroidery

With Yarn A embroider the nose onto the middle of the face, between Rounds 9 and 10 of the head. With black thread embroider the eyes between Rounds 9 and 12, 6 sts away from the nose. Continuously embroider the eyelashes starting from the upper point of the eyes towards the hair. With black thread embroider the eyebrows between Rounds 15 and 17, right above the eyes. With white thread, embroider a line to the outer side of the eyes, continuously embroider a small line onto the middle of the black part of the

Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn C Arms (make two)

Using Yarn A start with a magic ring Round 1 6dc into magic ring, pull rina tiaht [6dc]

Round 2 (1dc. inc) 3 times [9dc] Rounds 3-4 1dc in each st around Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn D Round 5 (2dc, invdec) 2 times, 1dc

> Rounds 6-9 1dc in each st around Change to Yarn B

Round 10 1dc in each st around Continue crocheting the top part of forehead. Divide the curls, and pin Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn E the arms using the tapestry crochet around two-thirds of them onto the technique

Round 11 (2dc, change to Yarn C, 1dc, change to Yarn B) 2 times, 1dc Fasten off Yarn C

Rounds 12-13 1dc in each st

Change to Yarn B, fasten off Yarn C around

Round 14 (2dc, change to Yarn D, 1dc, change to Yarn B) 2 times, 1dc Fasten off Yarn D

Rounds 15-16 1dc in each st around

Round 17 (2dc, change to Yarn E, 1dc. change to Yarn B) 2 times. 1dc Fasten off Yarn E


Round 18 1dc in each st around Fasten off, and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew them onto both sides of the doll between rounds 21 and

Round 1 using Yarn F start with a magic ring, 8dc into magic ring, pull ring tight [8dc]

Round 2 inc 8 times [16dc] Do not fasten off, continue with crocheting the curls

Round 3 1ss, ch25, 2dc in 2nd ch from hook, 2dc in each of next 9 sts,1dc in each of next 14 sts, ss into the starting dc, ch25, 2dc in 2nd ch from hook, 2dc in each of next 9 sts, 1dc in each of the next 14 sts, ss into the 2nd dc of Round 2; 2 curls have been completed into the 1st dc of Round 2, using this technique crochet 2 curls into each of the next 15dc of Round 2 Fasten off, and leave a long tail for

Place the hair on the top of the head. Secure the top of the hair with few pins onto the head. Part the hair in the middle of the head, to cover it completely. Sew the top of the hair onto its place, and continuously sew the curls onto the head. Arrange the rest of the curls onto the sewn curls,



G, embroider a hairclip above the first locks on both sides, starting between Rounds 15 and 16 of the head.

Boots (make two)

Using Yarn D ch6

Round 1 inc in the 2nd ch from hook, 3dc into next ch, 4dc into last ch, continue working on the other side of the foundation ch, 3dc, inc into last ch [14dc]

Round 2 inc twice, 3dc, inc 4 times, 3dc, inc twice [22dc] Change to Yarn G

Round 3 work this round in BLO. 1dc in each st around

Round 4 1dc in each st around Round 5 7dc. 8htr. 7dc

Round 6 7dc, invdec 4 times, 7dc [18dc]

Rounds 7-9 1dc in each st around Fasten off, and weave in the end Turn the boots upside down, with Yarn D join with a ss to a front loop of Round 2, ss into each of the front loops. Fasten off, weave the ends. Using Yarn E, start with a magic

Round 1 7dc in magic ring, pull rina tiaht [7dc]

Round 2 inc 7 times [14dc] **Round 3** (1dc, inc) 7 times [21dc] **Round 4** (2dc, inc) 7 times [28dc] Round 5 1dc, inc, (3dc, inc) 6 times,

2dc [35dc] **Round 6** (4dc, inc) 7 times [42dc] Round 7 work this round in BLO,

Rounds 8-9 1dc in each st around Round 10 (5dc. invdec) 6 times [36dc]

Rounds 11-13 1dc in each st around

1dc in each st around

Round 14 (4dc, invdec) 6 times

Rounds 15-17 1dc in each st around

Round 18 (3dc, invdec) 6 times [24dc]

Round 19 work this round in BLO, (2dc, invdec) 6 times [18dc] Round 20 (1dc, invdec) 6 times [18dc]

Watering can

Round 21 dec 6 times [6dc] Using a yarn needle, close the hole by inserting the needle through the back loops of the 6 sts, pull the tail to close the hole. Weave the end. With Yarn E join with a ss to a front loop of Round 18, 1ss into each of the front loops. Fasten off and weave ends. Turn the can upside down, join with a ss to a front loop of Round 6, 1ss into each of the front loops.

Handle Using Yarn E, start with a magic ring

Round 1 5dc in magic ring, pull ring tight [5dc]

Round 2-10 1dc in each st around Fasten off, sew the small hole, and leave a long tail

Spout Using Yarn E, start with a magic ring

Round 1 6dc in magic ring, pull ring tight [6dc] **Round 2** (1dc, inc) 3 times [9dc]

Round 3 inc, 3dc, invdec, 3dc [9dc]

Round 4 (2dc, inc) 3 times [12dc] Round 5 inc. 5dc. invdec. 4dc [12dc]

Round 6 (3dc, inc) 3 times [15dc] Round 7 1dc. inc. 6dc. invdec. 5dc [15dc]

Round 8 (4dc, inc) 3 times [18dc] Round 9 2dc, inc, 7dc, invdec, 6dc [18dc]

Fasten off, and leave a long tail for Stuff the spout slightly

Roses

Make 5, two each in Yarns C and D and one in Yarn G Ch12, 2htr in the 3rd ch from hook, 2htr in each of next 9ch [20sts] Fasten off, and leave a long tail for sewing. Roll up and with a few stitches sew at the base

Assembly

Sew the handle to the can between Rounds 8 and 9, and 16 and 17. Sew the spout to the opposite side between Rounds 8 and 16. Sew the roses onto the top of the can.
