

The World of Cross Stitching issue 363 (October 2025) Sew-It-All competition

1. The Promoter is Our Media Limited (company number 05715415) a company incorporated in England and Wales whose registered address is at Eagle House, Colston Avenue, Bristol, BS1 4ST.
2. The promotion is open to all residents of mainland UK aged 18 years or older, except the Promoter's employees or contractors and anyone connected with the promotion or their direct family members.
3. The closing date for entries is 23:59 on 2 September 2025.
4. By entering the promotion, the participants agree:
 - a. to be bound by these terms and conditions; and
 - b. that should they win the promotion, their name and likeness may be used by the Promoter for pre-arranged promotional purposes.
5. Entrants should enter by submitting their name and email address on the competition hosted on Gathered.how and agreeing to these terms and conditions. Entries received after the closing date of the promotion will not be considered.
6. Entrants must supply to Our Media Limited their name and email address as personal data is required for us to run the competition, choose winner(s) and arrange for the prize to be sent to the winner(s). 7. Only one entry will be permitted per person, regardless of method of entry. Bulk entries made by third parties will not be permitted.
8. Prizes the 5 winners will receive:
 - A fabric and accessories bundle worth £50.50. The bundle includes: 1 x clearance pack with eight pieces each 45x25cms (+/- 5%) with a mix of 14-count aida and 28-count cotton evenweave; 2 x deep square craft coasters; 2 x thread organiser with safety thread cutter; mix of five widths of aida band totalling 2.5m; 1 x cut piece of 1 x 14-count aida measuring 50x45cm and can choose between silver, gold, opalescent or plain.
9. The 5 winners will receive an email from Sew-It-All requesting their postal address (for the purpose of posting the prize only) and preferred fabric choice out of silver, gold, opalescent or plain. Sew-It-All will then post the kits once all winners have replied.
10. The winning entrants will be the first entry drawn at random from all the entries after the closing date. The Promoter's decision as to the winner is final and no correspondence relating to the promotion will be entered into. The Promoter may share the details of the winners with the prize provider for the purposes of fulfilling/delivering the prizes.
