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### Simply Knitting issue 200

#### Tickled Pink

The shade numbers for Platinum and Marshmallow were both given as 4051. Marshmallow should be 4054.

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#### Rose In Bloom

Chart A Row 9 should read: Sl 1 wyif, K1, yo, K5, ([K1, yo, sk2po, yo] twice, K2) to last 6 sts, K4, yo, K2.

Commence Chart A and Commence Chart B sections, Row 2 (WS and all following WS rows) should read: Sl 1 wyif, K1, P to last 2 sts, K2.

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### Simply Knitting issue 198

#### Knit Together charity pattern

The Drawn Eyelet Stitch is missing. The instructions should be: Insert the right-hand needle 2 rows below into the space between the k2tog and slip st, knit a st drawing up the loop onto the right-hand needle, K2 insert right-hand needle back into the same space between the k2tog and slip st (now 3 rows below) and knit a st drawing up the loop onto the right-hand needle.

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## May Day Magic

The row numbering is slightly wrong in one part of the pattern:

Break Yarn A and join Yarn F.

Row 11 \*Kfb; rep from \* to end. [12 sts]

Row 12 Purl.

**Row 13** \*K2, kfb; rep from \* to end. [16 sts]

**Row 14** Purl.

**Row 15** \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end. [12 sts]

**Row 16** Purl.

**Row 17** \*K2tog; rep from \* to end. [6 sts]

Break yarn and thread through rem sts. Pull tight to fasten.

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## Lace & Blooms knit-along blanket

On Square 2 the last few rows should read:

Rep Rows 6 to 13, four more times. **Rows 46 to 50** Knit. **Cast off.**

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## Simply Knitting issue 197

### Cheep, Cheep

BODY AND HEAD Cast on 12 sts using 3mm needles and **Yarn A.**

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## Lace & Flowers

There should be a note with the chart to say that the p2tog at the very beginning of Rnd 3 should be worked over the last stitch of Rnd 2 and the first stitch of Rnd 3.

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## Simply Knitting issue 195

### Heart cable jumper

#### **Wave Cable Panel**

**Row 11 and 12** Rep Rows 1 to 2 once more.

In the pattern printed in the magazine it says 'twice more'.

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## Ultimate Baby & Kids Knitting Collection

### Woof, Woof!

On the making up of the dogs ears, where it says Yarn B this should be Yarn E instead.

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## Amanda Berry Knitted Toy Collection

#### **Animal skittles (monkey)**

There is a row missing from the pattern in the monkey design

**Row 33** \*K5, k2tog; rep from \* to the last st, K1. [49 sts]

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## Simply Knitting Issue 193

### Delicate Blue (supplement)

The twisted stitch symbol in the chart key should say Ktbl on RS; Ptbl on WS.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 192

### My Little Angel

We have a correction to the yarn colours for this kit:

Yarn A is Peach (the darker beige/biscuit coloured yarn used for the main body of the angel).

Yarn C is Iced Pink (the pink coloured yarn used for the cheeks).

There's also a correction to the dress:

#### **CIRCULAR BASE OF THE DRESS**

Cast on 3 sts using 3mm needles and Yarn B.

**Row 1** (RS) (Kfb) to end. [6 sts]

**Row 2** (Kfb, K1) to end. [9 sts]

**Row 3** (Kfb, K1) four times, Kfb. [14 sts]

**Row 4** (Kfb, K2) four times, Kfb, K1. [19 sts]

**Row 5** (Kfb, K3) four times, Kfb, K2. [24 sts]

**Row 6** (Kfb, K4) four times, Kfb, K3. [29 sts]

Cast off.

Pull the fabric into a circular shape and sew up the seam from the centre to the edge of the circle. Join it to the hemline of the dress, sewing together one stitch of the hemline with one stitch of the circular base, continuing this way (stitch by stitch) until you have worked all the stitches around.

The row numbering on the hands is incorrect. It should be as follows:

Cast on 2 sts using 3mm needles and Yarn A for Hands.

**Row 1** (RS) (Kfb) to end. [4 sts]

Work 3 rows in st st, beg with a P row.

Change to Yarn B.

**Row 5** Kfb, K2, kfb. [6 sts]

**Row 6** Knit.

Work 5 rows in st st, begin with a K row.

**Row 12** P2tog, P2, p2tog. [4 sts]

Cast off.

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## Sweet Treats

Row 23 for the Back on both Master and Miss Gingerbread is missing the cast-on stitches that Row 23 for the Front has – so one of the arms won't be created for the back. Row 23 should be:

**BACK Row 23** With RS facing, rejoin yarn to 2 sets of 5 held sts, cast on 8 sts, K18. [18 sts]

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## Simply Knitting Issue 191

### The Snowman

The Left and Right feet are incorrectly labelled and worked in the wrong order. Please work as follows:

Knit the pattern labelled as “Left Foot and Leg” first, break the yarn and leave the stitches on a holder.

Next knit the part labelled “Right Foot and Leg”, but do not break off the yarn at the end of Row 24.

To join the legs, work as follows:

**Row 25** P26 sts on needle, with WS facing, P26 held sts. [52 sts]

Then continue as written.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 190

### Wild Willow

There's a mistake in rows 9-14 of the cable pattern.

#### **CABLE JUMPER**

#### **STITCH PATTERN**

Note Panel is worked over 8 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** K8.

**Row 2** P8.

**Row 3** C4B, C4F.

**Row 4** P8.

**Rows 5 to 6** As Rows 1 to 2.

**Row 7** T4B, T4F.

**Row 8** P2, K4, P2.

**Row 9** K2, P4, K2.

**Row 10** P2, K4, P2.

**Rows 11 to 14** Rep Rows 8 to 9 twice.

**Row 15** C4F, C4B.

**Row 16** P8.

**Rows 17 to 18** As Rows 1 to 2.

**Rows 19 to 20** As Rows 15 to 16.

These 20 rows form panel.

### Deep Sea Green (Stylecraft 30th Anniversary supplement)

Diamond and Moss St Block

**Row 15** P2 (3), K1, P1, Cr3L, P6, Cr3R, P1, K1, P2 (3).

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## Lacy Rainbows

There are errors in the written versions of the Left and Right Foot Charts:

Left Foot Chart

**Round 8** K0 (1: 2), P1, K3, yo, K3, ssk, K5, k2tog, K3, yo, K9, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 9 and foll odd rounds** K0 (1: 2), P1, K27, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 10** K0 (1: 2), P1, K4, yo, K3, ssk, K3, k2tog, K3, yo, K10, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 12** K0 (1: 2), P1, K5, yo, K3, ssk, K1, k2tog, K3, yo, K11, P1, K1 (2: 3).

Right Foot Chart

**Round 8** K0 (1: 2), P1, K5, k2tog, K3, yo, K3, ssk, K9, yo, K3, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 9 and foll odd rounds** K0 (1: 2), P1, K27, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 10** K0 (1: 2), P1, K10, yo, K3, ssk, K3, k2tog, K3, yo, K4, P1, K1 (2: 3).

**Round 12** K0 (1: 2), P1, K11, yo, K3, ssk, K1, k2tog, K3, yo, K5, P1, K1 (2: 3).

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## Sweet Moments (Stylecraft 30th Anniversary supplement)

The required yarn should read:

Yarn

Stylecraft Special Chunky XL

**Yarn A:** Emperor shade 1425 5 x 100g balls

**Yarn B:** Claret shade 1123 3 x 100g balls

**Yarn C:** Lime shade 1712 3 x 100g balls

NB: Claret is now discontinued. Lipstick (1246) is the closest shade to Claret.

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## Fresh Aqua

The armhole decreases on the Front of the top are incorrect in the second set. The row in bold is incorrect in the magazine.

### FRONT

#### SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off 5 (6: 7: 8: 9: 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows. [90 (94: 98: 102: 106: 110) sts]

**Next row (RS) K13 (14: 15: 16: 17: 18), skpo, patt to last 15 (16: 17: 18: 19: 20) sts, k2tog, K13 (14: 15: 16: 17: 18).** [2 sts dec'd]

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end.

Rep the last 4 rows once more. [86 (90: 94: 98: 102: 106) sts]

**Next row (RS) K13 (14: 15: 16: 17: 18), skpo, patt to last 15 (16: 17: 18: 19: 20) sts, k2tog, K13 (14: 15: 16: 17: 18).** [2 sts dec'd]

**Next row** Patt to end.

Rep the last 2 rows another 19 (20: 21: 22: 23: 24) times. [46 (48: 50: 52: 54: 56) sts]

Leave rem sts on a holder.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 187

### Happy Holidays

For the Radiator Grill, cast off the 5 sts remaining after Row 11.

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## Summer Stripes

The pattern says that Yarn B is Blue Mist 3945 – it should actually be White 7111.

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### Twit-twoo

There's a small error in the row numbering for the owl tea cosy.

In the FRONT

With Yarn A held double:

**Row 7** K5, (sl2, K6) twice, sl2, K5.

**Row 8** Purl.

**Row 9** Knit.

**Row 10** Purl.

With Yarn B held double:

**Row 11** K12, (turn, wyif sl1, wyib K3, turn, P4, K8) twice.

**Row 12** K12, (turn, P4, turn, K3, wyif sl1, wyib K8) twice.

With Yarn A held double:

**Row 13** K9, sl2, K6, sl2, K9.

Rep Rows 2 to 7 once more.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 186

### Feeling Peachy

The finishing instructions were missed off and should read as follows:

Finishing Sew up sole seam.

Sew on buttons to cuff to correspond with buttonholes. Ease cuff onto top of sock allowing a 1cm overlap for the buttonholes to line up with the buttons.

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## Tiny Dancer

Tutu **Cast on** 208 stitches in Yarn A. **Row 1** K2tog to end. [104 sts] **Row 2** P2tog to end. [52 sts] **Row 3** Knit. **Row 4** Purl. Repeat Rows 3 and 4, four more times. **Cast off** knitwise. Sew seam of tutu at the back using Yarn A. Sew the Tutu around the Ballerina's tummy using Yarn A.

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## Colour Palette (supplement)

The materials listing calls for 3.25mm needles – this should be 3.5mm. Then the Neckband instructions say to use 3.25mm needles, but should say 3.5mm.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 185

### You Got Whale!

2 body pieces should be knitted, not 1 as stated in the pattern.

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## Laid Back Lacework

The instructions on the purl rows should read "P to last 2 sts, K2", not P to last 3 sts.

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## Pawfect Pair (Super Socks supplement)

After working the ribbing in yellow, you need to work three rounds plain in grey before starting the chart:

BEGIN CHART Note When carrying one yarn unused across the back of your work for more than 5 sts, catch the unused yarn in the back of a st to prevent puckering your knitting.

Break off Yarn A and work three rounds in st st using Yarn B.

Begin working from Right Foot Chart, using Yarns B and C.

Work Rounds 1 to 24 of the Right Foot Chart twice and then Rounds 1 to 10 of Right Foot Chart once more.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 183

### Your Heart's Desire blanket knitalong

The colours for the intarsia heart squares were incorrect. They should read:

Square 1:

Colour 1 = Yarn E (Beryl)

Colour 2 = Yarn D (Peridot)

Colour 3 = Yarn A (Moon Stone)

Square 2:

Colour 1 = Yarn I (Danube)

Colour 2 = Yarn J (Nile)

Colour 3 = Yarn A (Moon Stone)

Square 3:

Colour 1 = Yarn K (Mekong)

Colour 2 = Yarn H (Rose Quartz)

Colour 3 = Yarn A (Moon Stone)

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### Aquamarina

After Row 1, it should say repeat the last row 9 times more (not the last 2 rows)

Rows 5 and 7 should read:

**Row 5** \*P1, yo, K1, s2kpo K1, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

**Row 7** \*P1, K1, yo, s2kpo, yo, K1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

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### Rock-a-Bye Baby

#### HEAD AND BODY

**Row 51** P19, sk2po, P19. [39 sts]

Work 31 rows in st st, beg with a knit row.

**Row 83** P1, (p2tog, P4) to last 2 sts, p2tog. [32 sts]

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## Heather Mist

Clarification on marker positioning:

### JOIN BODY AND SLEEVES

**Next round** Leave 5 (6: 6: 7: 7) sts on a holder, knit across 67 (73: 81: 89: 97) sts of Back, leave next 10 (12: 12: 14: 14) sts on a holder, knit across 48 (48: 52: 52: 54) sts of Sleeve, knit across 67 (73: 81: 89: 97) sts of Front, leave next 5 (6: 6: 7: 7) sts on holder with first 5 (6: 6: 7: 7) sts, knit across 48 (48: 52: 52: 54) sts of second Sleeve.

[230 (242: 266: 282: 302) sts]

Remove all markers except beg of round marker – move this to start of Front and knit to new start of round.

### SHORT ROW SHAPING FOR FRONT NECK

Place contrast marker 23 (26: 30: 34: 38) sts after start of round.

You will now cont in rows not rounds.

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## Jacket and Hat set (Royal Baby supplement)

The yarn suggested should be Sirdar Snuggly DK, not Sirdar Snuggly Cashmere Merino DK, which comes in smaller balls.

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## Sailor Blue (Royal Baby supplement)

### SWEATER BACK SHAPE NECK AND SHOULDER

**Next row** Patt 20 (21: 23: 23), patt2tog (neck edge), turn, leave rem 46 (51: 53: 55) sts on a stitch holder. [21 (22: 24: 24) sts]

Working on these 21 (22: 24: 24) sts only continue as follows:

**Next row** Patt.

Work 4 (8: 8: 8) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. [17 (14: 16: 16) sts]

**Next row** Cast off 5 (4: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [12 (10: 11: 11) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 6 (5: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [6 (5: 6: 6) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

Cast off rem 6 (5: 6: 6) sts in patt.

With RS facing, working on rem 46 (51: 53: 55) sts, slip 24 (28: 28: 30) sts onto a stitch holder for back of neck, rejoin yarn to rem 22 (23: 25: 25) sts, patt2tog (neck edge), patt to end. [21 (22: 24: 24) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

Work 4 (8: 8: 8) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. [17 (14: 16: 16) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 5 (4: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [12 (10: 11: 11) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 6 (5: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [6 (5: 6: 6) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

Cast off rem 6 (5: 6: 6) sts in patt.

## **FRONT SHAPE SHOULDER**

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next row. [21 (22: 24: 24) sts]

Work 4 (8: 8: 8) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. [17 (14: 16: 16) sts]

**Next row** Cast off 5 (4: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [12 (10: 11: 11) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 6 (5: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [6 (5: 6: 6) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

Cast off rem 6 (5: 6: 6) sts in patt.

With RS facing, working on rem 42 (47: 49: 51) sts, slip 16 (20: 20: 22) sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem 26 (27: 29: 29) sts and patt to end.

**Next row** Patt to end (neck edge).

Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. [24 (25: 27: 27) sts]

Work 3 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and foll alt row. [22 (23: 25: 25) sts]

Cont without shaping until Front measures 25 (27: 30: 32)cm, ending with a WS row. Place a marker at beg of last row for shoulder position.

**SHAPE SHOULDER** Work 2 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next row. [21 (22: 24: 24) sts]

Work 4 (8: 8: 8) rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every row. [17 (14: 16: 16) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 5 (4: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [12 (10: 11: 11) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

**Next row** Cast off 6 (5: 5: 5) sts in patt, patt to end. [6 (5: 6: 6) sts]

**Next row** Patt.

Cast off rem 6 (5: 6: 6) sts in patt.

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## Colour Splash (Royal Baby supplement)

**Row 1** (Dec) \*K to 2 sts before the SM, k2tog, sl SM, K1, sl1, K1, pss0; rep from \* 4 more times, K to end of row. [10 sts dec'd]

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## Simply Knitting Issue 182

### Mountain Peaks

Row 1 should say WS, not RS.

**Row 6** K2, \*insert needle under the long loose strands of 2 prev rows and knit the next st, K3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, insert needle under the long loose strands of 2 prev rows and knit the next st, K2.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 181

### Winter Warm

We missed the abbreviations from this pattern. They should be as follows (not as in the back of the magazine, as this pattern used the same ones with different meanings)

**C8F** Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, K4, K 4 from cable needle.

**T5B** Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold at back of work, K4, P1 from cable needle.

**T5F** Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, P1, K4 from cable needle.

**C4B** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, K2, K2 from cable needle.

**C4F** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, K2, K2 from cable needle.

**T3F** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, P1, K2 from cable needle.

**T3B** Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold at back of work, K2, P1 from cable needle.

**C3F** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, K1, K2 from cable needle.

**C3B** Slip 1 st to cable needle and hold at back of work, K2, K1 from cable needle.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 180

### Pretty Vintage

Rows 7, 9 and 11 should read:

K2, P2, work Row 2 of Lace Panel, P3, K16 (24: 32), P3, work Row 2 of Lace Panel, P2, K2.

The first 3 rows of increasing for Panel should read as follows:

**Next row** (RS inc row) K1, kfb, P2, work next row of Lace Panel, P3, K1, kfb, K12 (20: 28), kfb, K1, P3, work next row of Lace Panel, P2, kfb, K1.

Last row sets shaping, one st in from each edge and one stitch in from each side of the centre panel.

**Next row** (WS) P42, K3, P18 (26: 34), K3, purl to end.

**Next row** K3, P2, work next row of Lace Panel, P3, K18 (26: 34), P3, work next row of Lace Panel, P2, K3.

Rep last 2 rows once more, then work the first of these two rows again.

### **Sleepy Slip-ons (Nordic supplement)**

When you get to "For both Socks", cont working from the chart across all of the stitches (including those on the holder).

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## Simply Knitting Issue 179

### Happy Holidays

#### **FAIRY LIGHT TREE**

Cast on 41 sts using 3.5mm needles and green yarn. Knit the next 3 rows.

**Row 1** K1, sl1, K1, pss0, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

**Row 2** Purl.

Rep these 2 rows until you have 5 sts on the needles, ending with a purl row.

**Next row** K1, s2kpo, K1.

**Next row** Sl1, k2tog, pss0.

Fasten off the yarn.

#### **BUTTON TREE**

Cast on 17 sts using 3.5mm needles and green yarn. Knit to the end of the row.

**Row 1** K1, k2tog, K to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

**Rows 2-6** Knit.

Rep these 6 rows until you have 5 sts on the needles.

**Next row** K1, s2kpo, K1.

**Next row** Sl1, k2tog, pss0.

Fasten off the yarn.

#### **ELF**

Cast on 15 sts using 3.5mm needles and green yarn. Knit 1 row.

**Row 1** K1, k2tog, K to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

**Rows 2-4** Knit.

Rep these 4 rows until you have 5 sts on the needles.

**Next row** K1, s2kpo, K1.

**Next row** S11, k2tog, pssso.

Fasten off the yarn.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 178

### Squeak, Squeak

#### HEAD

**Row 5** K2, (kfb) 4 times, K2. [12 sts]

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## Simply Knitting Issue 175

### Beep, Boop

#### FRONT AND SIDES

Cast on 29 sts using 4mm needles and Yarn C.

**Row 1** (WS) Knit.

**Row 2** Knit.

**Row 3** K1, P5, K1, P15, K1, P5, K1.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3, 12 more times.

**Row 28** K1, P5, K1, k2tog, K11, k2tog, K1, P5, K1. [27 sts]

**Row 29** K1, P5, K1, p2tog, P9, p2tog, K1, P5, K1. [25 sts]

**Row 30** K1, P5, K1, k2tog, K7, k2tog, K1, P5, K1. [23 sts]

Cast off.

## **BOTTOM AND BACK**

Starting at the bottom – the cast on edge will join with the cast on edge of the front.

Cast on 17 sts using 4mm needles and Yarn C.

**Row 1** (WS) Knit.

**Row 2** Knit.

**Row 3** K1, P15, K1. [17 sts]

Repeat Rows 2 and 3, 4 more times.

**Row 12** Purl

**Row 13** K1, P15, K1.

**Row 14** Knit.

Repeat Rows 13 and 14, 11 more times, then work Row 13 once more.

**Row 38** K1, k2tog, K11, k2tog, K1. [15 sts]

**Row 39** K1, p2tog, P9, p2tog, K1. [13 sts]

**Row 40** K1, k2tog, K7, k2tog, K1. [11 sts]

Cast off.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 174

### Roof Garden

Row 14 should read Row 13 and Row 15 should read Row 14. Then repeat Rows 12-14 three more times.

The Eyelet row will then be on Row 27 (a RS row).

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### Place in the Sun

The yarn weight should be 4ply, not DK.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 173

### Coral Beach

Back should say Cast on using Yarn B.

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### Ocean Waves

The Shape Shoulder sections of the Left Front and Back should read as follows:

#### **Left Front – Shape shoulder**

Cast off loosely 6 (6: 7: 8: 8: 9) sts at beg of next row and the 2 foll alt rows.

Work 1 row straight.

Cast off loosely 5 (6: 7: 7: 9: 9) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row straight.

Cast off rem 5 (7: 7: 7: 9: 9) sts.

(Right front should be worked the same in reverse)

#### **Back – Shape Shoulder**

Cast off loosely 6 (6: 7: 8: 8: 9) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then 5 (6: 7: 7: 9: 9) sts at beg of next 2 rows, finally cast off 5 (7: 7: 7: 9: 9) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Slip rem 32 (34: 36: 38: 40: 42) st on a stitch holder and leave.

There should also be a note in the "To Make Up" instructions to say that the Pocket Linings should be slipped stitched into place.

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## Simply Knitting Issue 172

### Rose Garden

Page 10, Column 2

Row 2 should read as follows: Beg with st 2 (5: 8: 3: 6: 1: 4: 7) and reading Chart from left to right, P to end of Row 2 of Body Chart, then rep sts 8-1 a further 12 (12: 12: 14: 14: 15: 16: 16) times, P1 (4: 7: 2: 5: 8: 3: 6), following Body Chart st 8- 8 (5: 2: 7: 4: 1: 6: 3).

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## Touch of Silk (Spring Supplement)

Knot stitch: Row 3 should read K3, \*K10, (p3tog, k3tog, k3tog into next 3 sts); rep from \* to last 10 sts, K10.

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## Lovely in Lavender (Spring Supplement)

Page 16, Column 2

The stitch count should be 115 (113: 111) after the cast off, and then back to 150 again after the cast on.

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## Cosy & Comfy

The pocket top ribs should be added afterwards. Once the pocket is complete, pick up and knit 24 sts along the top edge, and work in (K1, P1) rib for 6 rows. Cast off in rib. Sew the sides of the ribbing down each side and weave in ends.

**Round 1** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 1 from Right Hand Chart, PM, M1, PM, work in rib as set to end. [43 (47: 51) sts]

**Round 2** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 2 from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, k1tbl, sl sm, rib as set to end.

**Round 3** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 3 from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, M1R, k1tbl, M1L, sl sm, rib as set to end. [45 (49: 53) sts]

**Round 4** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 4 from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, P1, k1tbl, P1, sl sm, rib as set to end.

**Round 5** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 5 from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, M1R, P1, k1tbl, P1, M1L, sl sm, rib as set to end. [47 (51: 55) sts]

**Round 6** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work Row 6 from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, (k1tbl, P1) twice, k1tbl, sl sm, work in rib as set to end.

**Round 7** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work next row from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, M1R, work in rib as set to next marker, M1L, sl sm, rib as set to end. [49 (53: 57) sts]

**Round 8** (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times, work next row from Right Hand Chart, sl sm, rib as set to next sm, sl sm, rib as set to end.

### LEFT GUSSET

(should read)

**Round 1** (K1tbl, P1) 10 (11: 12) times, k1tbl, PM, M1, PM, work Row 1 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times. [43 (47: 51) sts]

**Round 2** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, k1tbl, sl sm, work Row 2 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times.

**Round 3** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, M1R, k1tbl, M1L, work Row 3 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times. [45 (49: 53) sts]

**Round 4** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, P1, k1tbl, P1, sl sm, work Row 4 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times.

**Round 5** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, M1R, P1, k1tbl, P1, M1L, work Row 5 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times. [47 (51: 55) sts]

**Round 6** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, (k1tbl, P1) twice, k1tbl, sl sm, work Row 6 from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times.

**Round 7** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, M1R, work in rib as set to next marker, M1L, sl sm, work next row from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times. [49 (53: 57) sts]

**Round 8** Work in rib as set to marker, sl sm, work in rib as set to next marker, sl sm, work next row from Left Hand Chart, (P1, k1tbl) 0 (1: 2) times.

Cast on with B not A.

Rows 3, 5 and 7 should not say P2, C6B, P3 at the end of these rows but P2, K6, P3.

### Basic Figure

#### Left Leg (page 6)

Cast on 10 sts using 3.25mm needles and Yarn A.

**Row 1** (Kfb) to end of row. [20 sts]

Beg with a purl row, st st 5 rows.

**Row 7** K7, (k3tog) 4 times, K1. [12 sts]

Beginning with a purl row, st st 11 rows.

Break off Yarn A and join in Yarn B.

#### Headdress (page 6)

**Row 9** Knit to end.

**Row 10** Knit across all stitches.

Waistcoat (page 7)

After Row 21, rejoin yarn to knit centre 24 sts, leave 8 sts at the side.

### **First Star (page 10)**

**Row 3** (Kfb) to end of row.

### **Jesus**

After Row 29, break off yarn and thread through remaining stitches.

### **Lamb**

When the lamb is complete, break the yarn and thread through the remaining 10 sts.

We put the wrong yarn information for this project. It should say Stylecraft, Special XL (100% acrylic, 200g/136m), 5 balls of Yarn A Emperor (1425) and 3 balls each of Yarn B Claret (1123) and Yarn C Lime (1712).

The smaller size needle should be 3.75mm throughout.

The Cable Pattern should read as follows:

**Row 1 (RS)** Knit.

**Row 2 and all alternate rows** Purl.

**Row 7** K5 (3:7), C4F, C4B, \*K4, C4F, C4B; rep from \* to last 5 (3:7) sts, K5 (3:7).

**Row 8** Purl.

When working the thumb, rounds 2-4 should be worked until there are 21 sts, not 20, and every instance of 20 should say 21.

The row that reads "Next row (WS) K to marker, turn, inc 9 sts evenly across row" just before the Front section should read as follows:

**Next row** Knit (to mark a turning row), increasing 9 sts evenly.

There are no markers used in the cushion, this was an error on our part when we wrongly 'corrected' the original pattern.

After "Dec 1 st at each end of next row" it should say [2 sts dec'd] instead of 1 st dec'd.

Row 3 should read: K6, K1, \*skpo, yrn twice, k2tog; rep from \* to last st, K1.

### Shape Raglan

This section should read as follows:

Cast off 6 (6: 7: 8) sts at beg of next row. [49 (53: 60: 63) sts]

Work 1 WS row.

Dec 1 st at raglan end of next 1 (1: 5: 7) rows. [48 (52: 55: 56) sts]

**Next row** (WS) Patt without shaping.

**Next row** (RS) Dec 1 st at beg of row. [1 st dec'd]

Repeat the last 2 rows until 33 ( 35: 37: 39) sts rem ending with a wrong side row.

### **Shape Neck**

**Next row** K2tog, patt across 15 (16: 18: 19) sts, turn and work on these sts, leaving rem 16 (17: 17: 18) sts on a holder for neckband.

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 (4: 4: 5) sts at neck edge of next row, patt to end. 12 (13: 13: 13) sts

**Next row** K2tog (0: 1: 1: 1) time, patt to last 2 sts, work 2tog. 11 sts.

**Next row** Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 8 sts.

Dec 1 st at end of row. 8

Rep the last row 8 times more.

Mark positions for 6 buttons along left front border. First to be approx 8cm from hem and last to be placed at top of neck edge.

### **Right Front**

Begin working the Right Front as folls:

Cast on 60 (64: 72: 76) sts.

K 4 rows.

Change to 4mm needles.

**Row 1** (WS) K2, P2; rep from \* to last 8 sts, K8.

**Row 2** K6, \*P2, K2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

**Row 3** K1, \*skpo, yrn twice, k2tog; rep from \* to last 7 sts, K7.

**Row 4** K6, \*P2, kfb into yrn of previous row; rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

These 4 rows form patt with 6 sts worked in g st for border.

Cont in patt until work measures 10cm, ending with a RS row, AT THE SAME TIME working buttonholes as folls to match marked placements on left front:

**Buttonhole row (RS)** Patt to last 6 sts, K2, yo, K2tog, K2.

When work meas 10cm, cont to work as folls, remembering to work buttonholes throughout.

**Dec row (WS)** Dec 1 st at beg of row. [1 st dec'd]

Continue to work as printed from "work 13 rows in pattern"

### **Shape Raglan**

Work this section as folls:

Cast off 6 (6: 7: 8) sts at beg of next row. [49 (53: 60: 63) sts]

Dec 1 st at raglan end of next 1 (1: 5: 7) rows. [48 (52: 55: 56) sts]

**Next row (WS)** Patt without shaping.

**Next row (RS)** Dec 1 st at beg of row. [1 st dec'd]

Repeat the last 2 rows until 33 (35: 37: 39) sts rem ending with a right side row.

### **Shape Neck**

Next row Patt to last 2 sts, work 2tog. 32 [34: 36: 38] sts.

Patt across 16 (17: 19: 20) sts, turn and work on these sts, leaving rem 16 (17: 17: 18) st on a holder for neckband.

Keeping patt correct, cast off 4 (4: 4: 5) sts at neck edge of next row, patt to end. [12 (13: 13: 13) sts]

**Next row** K2tog (0: 1: 1: 1) time, patt to last 2 sts, work 2tog. [11 sts]

**Next row** Cast off 3 sts, patt to end. 8 sts.

Dec 1 st at end of row. 8

Rep the last row 8 times more.

---

## Simply Knitting issue 157

### Afternoon Tea

A couple of the numbers are wrong in the size 12 pattern.

BACK and FRONT should both begin: Cast on 94 (98: **104**: 110: 118: 122: 126: 134) sts using 3.25mm needles.

Then on the armhole decreases, again on both Back and Front, it should read:

These 2 rows set armhole shaping. Dec 1 st as set at each end of next 1 (1: **1**: 3: 3: 3: 3: 5) rows, then on 2 (3: 2: 2: 3: 3: 3: 3) foll alt rows. [75 (79: 83: 85: 89: 93: 95: 99) sts]

---

### Purple Haze

After the Back and Front shaping is complete, the knitter is asked to leave sts on a holder. This line was in error and should be ignored, as the next section will be knitted on these stitches.

During the wrap and turn section at the end of the neck shaping, on some sizes the w&t will end up in a cable. If you find this isn't tidy for you, you can place the wrap in the purl sts to one side of the cable instead.

---

### Chick Tea Cosy

Row 8 should read: (RS) K1, k2tog, yo, K3, \*yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, K3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, yo, k2togtbl, K1.

---

### Bunny jumper

The "TO MAKE UP" instructions should say:

Press pieces according to the ball band instructions. Place back so that shaped section of back shoulder lays on top of the shaped section of front shoulder, matching markers. Loosely sew the overlapped rows together at armhole edge only. Sew sleeves seams and side seams. Place the centre point of the top of the sleeve to the marker. With right sides together pin the sleeve into the armholes, sew into place using small backstitches. Sew in all ends. Make a pompom using Yarn B and attach to the bunny motif.

---

## Simple Knits Hat

The Shape Top section should be worked as follows:

**Next row** K16, PM, K2, P15, PM, P2, K15, PM, K2, P15, PM, P3.

**Next row** (Dec) K1, k2tog, K to sm, sl sm, ssk, p2tog, P to sm, sl sm, p2togtbl, k2tog, K to sm, sl sm, ssk, p2tog, P to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, P1. [8 sts dec'd]

Patt 1 row.

Rep the last 2 rows until 22 sts rem.

## Modern Girl

The tension was wrong for this pattern and should read:

16 sts and 26 rows to measure 10x10cm (4x4in) over pattern stitch using 7mm needles

16 sts and 22 rows to measure 10x10cm (4x4in) over stocking stitch using 5.5 mm needles

After the cast on row, change to 7mm needles before working in pattern stitch.

All the pattern stitch sections will be on 7mm needles and the st st sections on 5.5mm needles.

## In the Garden

There has been some confusion about how the first 2 rows of pattern are worked. Hopefully this should make it clearer:

**Row 1** (RS) P1 (1: 1: 0: 2: 1: 1: 2), (K2, P2) 0 (1: 0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 0) times, work first 6 sts of Chart, repeat the sts in the repeat box 8 (8: 9: 9: 10: 11: 11: 12) times, work last 6 sts of chart, (P2, K2) 0 (1: 0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 0) times, P1 (1: 0: 0: 2: 1: 1: 2).

**Row 2 (WS)** K1 (1: 1: 0: 2: 1: 1: 2), (P2, K2) 0 (1: 0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 0) times, work 6 sts of Chart before repeat, repeat the sts in the the repeat box 8 (8: 9: 9: 10: 11: 11: 12) times, work the last 6 sts of chart, (K2, P2) 0 (1: 0: 1: 0: 0: 1: 0) times, K1 (1: 0: 0: 2: 1: 1: 2).

## Winter Walks Poncho

In the right front, the first 2 rows are worked until the piece measures 5cm. It then says: "Rep last 2 rows until work meas 8cm". This is a cut-and-paste error from placing the pattern into our house style and should be crossed out.

Also the buttonhole rows throughout should read: K6, K2tog, yo, work to end.

All over Cable Pattern

(Multiple of 16 sts and 6 rows)

**Row 1 (RS)** K4, C4B, C4F, K4.

The last cable on Row 5 was printed incorrectly.

Please work the cushion back pieces as follows, working the Upper Back in Yarn A and the Lower Back in Yarn B:

Cast on 59 sts using 8mm needles.

**Row 1 (RS)** P2, Ktbl, P2, \*K4, P2, Ktbl, P2; rep from \* to **end**.

**Row 2 (WS)** K2, Ptbl, K2, \*P4, K2, Ptbl, K2; rep from \* to **end**.

**Row 3** P2, Ktbl, P2, \*C4B, P2, Ktbl, P2; rep from \* to **end**.

**Row 4** K2, Ptbl, K2, \*P4, K2, Ptbl, K2; rep from \* to **end**.

These 4 rows set cable pattern.

Repeat rows 1–4 another 7 times more.

Then work as per the pattern.
