Golden Hour

Yarn quantities needed should be: 7 (8: 8: 9: 9: 10: 10) x 50g balls.

Simply Knitting issue 249

Little Rosie

The pattern jumps from Row 19 to Row 23. The rows are not missing, the numbers for the rows are incorrect. Follow the instructions ignoring the row numbers.

The button band and button hole band instructions after cast off should say: Using mattress stitch, attach side of band to side of cardigan.

Simply Knitting issue 247

Brick Layer

Under Back, Shape Raglan, after the 4 row repeat to [72 (78: 86: 86: 88) sts], the instructions should say: Now rep **Rows 3 and 4** only until 32 (36: 38: 42: 44) sts rem, ending after a WS row.

BODY

Row 16 (K7, kfb) 3 times, (kfb, K7) 3 times. [54 sts]

Rows 17 to 19 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 20 K1, ssk, K21, kfb, K4, kfb, K21, k2tog, K1.

Rows 22 to 27 Rep Rows 20 & 21 three times.

Rows 28 to 31 Starting on a RS knit row, work in st st.

Row 32 (K7, K2tog) 5 times, K6, K2tog, k1. [48 sts]

Row 34 (K6, K2tog) 5 times, k5, K2tog, K1. [42 sts]

Rows 35 to 37 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 38 (K5, K2tog) 5 times, K4, K2tog, k1. [36 sts]

Rows 39 to 43 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 44 (K4, K2tog) 5 times, K3, K2tog, K1. [30 sts]

Rows 45 to 55 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 56 (K3, K2tog) 5 times, k2, K2tog, k1. [24 sts]

Rows 57 to 59 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Cast off.

Next row (WS) Work Row 4 of Lace Pattern to SM, slm, M1L, P4, M1R, slm, P48 (48: 48: 48: 56: 56: 56: 56), slm as you come to them, M1L, P4, M1R, slm, Work Row 4 of Lace Pattern to end. [124 (124: 124: 124: 132: 132: 132: 132) sts, including: 32 sts (right collar), 6 sts (right front), 10 (10: 10: 10: 12: 12: 12: 12) sts (right sleeve), 28 (28: 28: 28: 32: 32: 32: 32) sts (back), 10 (10: 10: 10: 12: 12: 12: 12) sts (left sleeve), 6 sts (left front), 32 sts (left collar)]

Outer Cover

Right-Facing Body

Rows 11 and 19 should be: K to last 2 sts, kfb, K1.

Inner Lining

Right-Facing Body and Head

Cast on **36 sts** not 48 sts.

Under 'Forelegs', row numbers 21-43 should be labelled rows 33-55.

Simply Knitting issue 239

Lace cardigan, page 14

Once the sleeve seams are joined, pick up and knit 92 (98: 98: 194: 194: 109: 109: 115) sts around sleeve edge. Knit 6 rows. Cast off. Repeat on the other side.

Elmer jumper, page 27

Front instructions are for the Back, and Back instructions are for the Front.

SHAPE NECK **Next row (RS) K36 (40: 45: 48: 53: 57), turn. Cont on this group of 36 (40: 45: 48: 53: 57) sts for left half of neck. Next row (WS) P1, P2tog, P to end. [1 st dec'd] Next row K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. [1 st dec'd] Rep the last 2 rows once, then first of these rows again.** [31 (35: 40: 43: 48: 52) sts] Work 14 (16: 16: 18: 20: 20) rows straight thus ending at side edge.

Pattern and puzzler book, shadow shawl

Row 1 should read: K20, pm, K1, pm, K20

Under work st st and eyelet panel: Beg with a K row, work 7 (7: 7: 9: 9: 9) rows in st st, ending with WS facing for next row. Next row (WS) Knit. Next row *K2tog, yo; rep from * to last st, K1. Next row Knit. Beg with a K row, work 7 (7: 7: 9: 9: 9) rows in st st, ending with WS facing for next row. Next row Knit. Next row K0 (0: 0: 1: 2: 1), *K3, yo, sk2po, yo; rep from * to last 3 (3: 3: 4: 5: 4) sts, K3 (3: 3: 4: 5: 4). Next row Purl. Next row K0 (0: 0: 1: 2: 1), *K3, yo, sk2po, yo; rep from * to last 3 (3: 3: 4: 5: 4) sts, K3 (3: 3: 4: 5: 4). Next row Purl. Next row K1 (1: 1: 1: 2: 1), (k2tog, yo) 1 (1: 1: 0: 0: 0) time, (yo, sk2po, yo) 0 (0: 0: 1: 1: 1) time, *K3, yo, sk2po, yo; rep from * to last 6 (6: 6: 7: 8: 7) sts, K3, (yo, sk2po, yo) 0 (0: 0: 1: 1: 1) time, (yo, ssk) 1 (1: 1: 0: 0: 0) time, K1 (1: 1: 1: 2: 1). Next row Purl. **Last 6 rows form patt. Work rows 1-4 of this 6-row patt once more.**

Under set pattern, after shaping armholes on the back: **Row 5** K2 (2: 2: 1: 1: 2), (k2tog, yo) 1 (1: 1: 1: 1: 0) time, *K3, yo, sk2po, yo; rep from * to last 7 (7: 7: 6: 6: 5) sts, K3, (yo, ssk) 1 (1: 1: 1: 1: 0) time, K2 (2: 2: 1: 1: 2) Under set pattern, after shaping armholes on the back: Row 5 K2 (2: 2: 1: 1: 2), (k2tog, yo) 1 (1: 1: 1: 1: 0) time, *K3, yo, sk2po, yo; rep from * to last 7 (7: 7: 6: 6: 5) sts, K3, (yo, ssk) 1 (1: 1: 1: 1: 0) time, K2 (2: 2: 1: 1: 2)

Cable T-shirt, p14

Front (after changing to 5mm needles):

Row 1 (RS) K25 (29: 35: 39: 45: 49), work Row 1 of Chart, K25 (29: 35: 39: 45: 49).

Baby cardigan, p61

The sleeve decreases should read:

Row 1 (RS) K2, SSK, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, K2 sts. [2 sts dec'd].

Work 3 rows straight in st st.

Rep the last 4 rows a further 2 (4: 4: 4: 5) times. 30 (28: 28: 32: 32) sts.

Row 1 (RS) K2, SSK, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, K2 sts. [2 sts dec'd].

Work 1 row straight in st st.

Rep the last 2 rows a further 7 (6: 6: 7: 7) times. 14 (14: 14: 16: 16) sts.

Eyes Front:

Rows 2 to 5 Knit.

Simply Knitting issue 233

Cross-over Wrap, p21

Row 11 K4, P4, C8F, P4, (C8F) 3 times, P4, C8F, P4, K4.

The Knitted Year Blanket KAL, p49

Berries Panel should read: **Row 1 (RS)** K5, P5, K1tbl, P7, K2, P7, K1tbl, P5, K5. **Row 2** K4, P1, K5, P1, work Row 1 of Pattern panel, P1, K5, P1, K4. **Row 3** K5, P5, K1tbl, work Row 2 of pattern panel, K1tbl, P5, K5.

Simply Knitting issue 232

Darling Denim baby dungarees (page 26)

Front: the row after Join Legs should read **Next row** With RS facing, K to last 2 (4: 4: 6) sts of second leg, PM, K (2: 4: 4: 6), cast on 12 (8: 6: 4) sts, K 2 (4: 4: 6) sts on first leg, pm, K to end of row.

Front: the row after Dec Row on Crotch Shaping should read: Work Dec row on next row and then every 4th (4th: 6th: 6th), 5 (5: 5: 6) more times

The Knitted Year Blanket KAL (page 49)

Row 1 of Rice Stitch Panel should read: K5, *K1, P1; rep from * to last 5 sts, K4.

Cosy in Cocoa men's cardigan (page 64)

Before armhole shaping on Left and Right Front, Change to 5mm needles, and work in patterned rib until piece measures same as back to armhole shaping.

Simply Knitting issue 231

Peter Rabbit and Mrs Rabbit

On the arms of Mrs Rabbit the pattern reads 'Rows 9 to 15: Starting on a WS purl row work in st st.' The pattern should read Rows 9 to 11, not Rows 9 to 15.

The Knitted Year Blanket KAL

The abbreviations Tw2F and Tw2B are the wrong way around.

Honeycomb Panel: **Row 2** K5, purl to last 5 sts, K5

Wheat Ears Panel: After row 21, it should read 'repeat last 20 rows once more'

Simply Knitting issue 226

Zebra Pinnie

Under 'shape bib' row 2 should read: S11, K4, purl to last 5 sts, K5 and row 4 should be: S11, K4, purl to last 5 sts, K5

Under the Sea

The stitch count for row 81 of the lower tentacles should be 12, not 10.

Row 82 should say P4tog, not P3tog.

For the lower tentacles, these are worked shorter than the upper ones and stretched slightly when sewing up. There aren't any casting off instructions because the live stitches are attached directly to the body as detailed in the making up section.

Charming Rose

Rows 3 to 11 Starting with a WS purl row work 9 rows in st st. Change to Yarn A. **Row 12** (RS) *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Fancy a Dip?

Front of Beach Hut **Rows 9 to 52** Work as Rows 1 to 8, keeping the four-row stripe sequence correct. Break off Yarn B, cont in Yarn A only. **Row 53** Knit.

Cover for Hook of Hanger – Use Yarn C

Kid's flower cardi

When dividing for sleeves and body, the pattern says you should begin with a knit row when the pattern needs you to begin with a purl row.

Simply Knitting issue 224

Slip Stitch Cardigan

Pattern Note Missing:

When shaping raglans, work shapings as set below:

Row 1 (RS) K1, s1, K1, pssso, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

Row 2 (WS) P1, p2tog, patt to last 3 sts, p2togtbl, P1.

BACK

Ribbing:

Row 2 (WS) *P2, K2; rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

First stitch pattern:

Row 3 K4 (4:1:3:4), *K1, place right hand needle below strand on Row 1, **K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last 3 (3:0:2:3) sts, K3 (3:0:2:3).

Row 7 K2 (2:3:1:2), *K1, place right hand needle below strand on **Row 5**, **K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last 1 (1:2:0:1) sts, K1 (1:2:0:1).

LEFT FRONT

Ribbing:

Row 2 (WS) K1, *P2, K2; rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

First stitch pattern:

Row 3 K4 (4:1:3:4), *K1, place right hand needle below strand on Row 1, **K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 5 K2 (2: 3: 1: 2), *yfwd, slip next 3 sts, ybk, K1; rep from * to last st, **K1**.

Row 7 K2 (2:3:1:2), *K1, place right hand needle below strand on **Row 5, K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last st, **K1**.

Shape Raglan and Front Neck

Work 1 (1: 0: 0: 0) row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Purl next 2 rows, and at same time dec 1 st as set at raglan edge of next 1 (1: 1: 2: 2) rows. [27 (28: 31: 35: 39) sts]

Next row K1, sl1, K1, pss0, ***K1, yfwd, sl1, ybk**; rep from * to last 4 (1: 0: 0: 0) sts, (**K1, k2tog**) 1 (0: 0: 0: 0) time, K1 (1: 0: 0: 0).

Next row Purl to last 0 (0: 0: 3: 3) sts, (p2togtbl P1) 0 (0: 0: 1: 1) times.

Next row K1, sl1, K1, pss0, K0 (0: 0: 1: 1], *yfwd, sl1, ybk, K1; rep from * to last 0 (**4: 3: 4: 4**) sts, (yfwd, sl1, ybk) 0 (**1: 0: 1: 1**) time, (k2tog) 0 (1: 1: 1: 1) time, K1.

Next row Purl to last 0 (0: 0: 3: 3) sts, (p2togtbl, P1) 0 (0: 0: 1: 1) times. [24 (25: 28: 30: 34) sts]

These 4 rows set patt and shaping.

RIGHT FRONT

Next row Rib to end, dec 0 (0: 0: 1: 0) sts and inc 0 (**0: 1: 0: 0**) st at beg of row. [39 (43: 48: 54: 59) sts]

First stitch patt:

Row 1 K3, *yfwd, slip next 3 sts, ybk, **K1**; rep from * to last 4 (4: 1: 3: 4) sts, K4 (4: 1: 3: 4).

Row 2 and every foll alt row Purl.

Row 3 K3, *K1, place right-hand needle below strand on Row 1, **K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last 4 (4: 1: 3: 4) sts, K4 (4: 1: 3: 4).

Row 5 **K1**, *yfwd, slip next 3 sts, ybk, K1; rep from * to last 2 (**2: 3: 1: 2**) sts, **K2 (2: 3: 1: 2)**.

Row 7 **K1** ***K1**, place right-hand needle below strand on Row 5, **K1, pulling the yarn through both the st and the strand**, K2; rep from * to last 2 (**2: 3: 1: 2**) sts, **K2 (2: 3: 1: 2)**.

Row 8 Purl.

These 8 rows set pattern.

Cont in patt as set until work measures 44 (45: 46: 47: 48)cm ending with **RS** facing for next row.

SHAPE RAGLAN AND FRONT NECK changed to match left side as follows:

Keeping patt as set cont as folls:

Next row (RS) Patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

Next row Cast off 6 (7: 8: 9: 10) sts, patt to end.

[32 (35: 39: 44: 48) sts]

Working dec as set on back, dec 1 st at raglan edge of next 1 (5: 6: 6: 6) rows, then on 2 (0: 0: 0: 0) foll alt row and at same time dec

1 st at neck edge of 5th row. [28 (29: 32: 37: 41) sts]

Work 1 (1: 1: 0: 0) row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Purl next 2 rows, and at same time dec 1 st as set at raglan edge of next 1 (1: 1: 2: 2) rows.
[27 (28: 31: 35: 39) sts]

Next row (RS) (K1, sl1, K1, pss0) 1 (0:0:0:0) time, *K1, yfwd, sl1, ybk; rep from * to last 4 (4:3:3:3) sts, K1 (1:0:0:0), k2tog, K1.

Next row (P1, p2tog) 0 (0:0:1:1) time, purl to end.

Next row (K1, sl1, K1, pss0) 0 (1:1:1:1) time, *yfwd, sl1, ybk, K1; rep from * to last 3 (4:3:4:4) sts, (yf, sl1, yb) 0 (1:0:1:1), k2tog, K1.

Next row (P1, p2tog) 0 (0:0:1:1) time, purl to end.

[24 (25: 28: 30: 34) sts]

These 4 rows set alternating slip stitch pattern and shaping.

Work 27 (29: 33: 35: 37) rows, dec 1 st as set at raglan edge of next 1 (1: 1: 3: 7) rows then on 13 (14: 16: 16: 15) foll alt row and at same

time dec 1 st at neck edge of 1st (3rd: 3rd: 5th: 3rd) and 6 (6: 7: 7: 8) foll 4th rows. [3 sts]

Next row (WS) P3tog.

Fasten off.

SLEEVES (Make 2)

Cast on 42 (46: 50: 50: 54) sts using 4mm straight needles.

Work 4 (4: 4: 5: 5)cm, in rib as set on back, ending with WS facing for next row.

Next row Rib to end, **dec 0 (0: 1: 0: 1) st and inc 1 (1: 0: 1: 0) st** at end of row. [43 (47: 49: 51: 53) sts]

SHAPE RAGLAN - section changed as follows:

Cast off 6 (7: 8: 9: 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

[55 (57: 59: 65: 65) sts]

Size 3 only

Work 2 rows in patt without shaping.

All sizes

Next row K1, sl1, K1, pssso, patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1.

This row sets raglan shaping.

Size 5 only

Dec 1st as set at each end of the next 2 rows.

All sizes

Dec 1 st as set at each end of every foll alt row until there are 15 sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem sts.

BUTTONBAND

For ladies' version

Next row Rib 3 (3: 2: 3: 3), [cast off 2 sts, **rib 12 (12: 13: 13: 13)**] 6 times, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

For men's version

Next row Rib to last 89 (89: 94: 95: 95) sts, [cast off 2 sts, **rib 12 (12: 13: 13: 13)**] 6 times, cast off 2 sts, rib to end.

Simply Knitting issue 220

Quick and easy winter knits supplement: Chunky cardigan

For the left front:

Row 5 Knit to last 13 sts, P1, (K1, P1) twice, gather 3, P1, K1, P1, K2.

Row 6 (K1, P1), 6 times, K1, purl to end.

Simply Knitting issue 219

Floral blanket KAL

Under 'daisy' row 1 should read: K13A, work Row 1 of Daisy Chart, K13A

Simply Knitting issue 218

Cable cushion

T3B should read: Slip next stitch onto cn and hold at the back of work. K2, P1 from cn

Shawl

Stitch Pattern A Rows 2 and 4 should be the other way around, so Row 2 is the Row 4 instructions, and Row 4 should say 'As Row 2'.

Stitch Pattern B, Row 3 K3, *K1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, K1, P1; rep from * to last 9 sts, K1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, K4.

Lace Wings stitch of the month p98

Twisted ssk – S11 pwise, s11 kwise, return 2 sts to LH needle, knit into the front of both stitches

Cast on 7 sts using 4mm needles and Yarn B.

Rows 1 to 4 Using Yarn B, knit. **Row 5** Using Yarn E, K3, yo, pm, K1, yo, K3. [9 sts]

Rows 6 to 10 Using Yarn E, knit.

Row 11 Using Yarn C, K4, yo, K1, yo, K4. [11 sts]

Rows 12 to 16 Using Yarn C, knit. **Row 17** Using Yarn A, K5, yo, K1, yo, K5. [13 sts]

Rows 18 to 22 Using Yarn A, knit.

Row 23 Using Yarn D, K6, yo, K1, yo, K6. [15 sts]

Rows 24 to 28 Using Yarn D, knit. **Row 29** Using Yarn B, K7, yo, K1, yo, K7. [17 sts]

Row 30 to 34 Using Yarn B, knit.

Row 35 Using Yarn C, K8, yo, K1, yo, K8. [19 sts]

Row 36 to 40 Using Yarn C, knit. **Row 41** Using Yarn A, K9, yo, K1, yo, K9. [21 sts]

Row 42 to 46 Using Yarn A, knit. **Row 47** Using Yarn E, K10, yo, K1, yo, K10. [23 sts]

Row 48 to 52 Using Yarn E, knit. **Row 53** Using Yarn D, K11, yo, K1, yo, K11. [25 sts]

Row 54 to 58 Using Yarn D, knit.

SIZES S, M, L, 1XL, AND 2XL ONLY **Row 59** Using Yarn A, K12, yo, K1, yo, K12. [27 sts]

Row 60 to 64 Using Yarn A, knit.

SIZES M, L, 1XL, AND 2XL ONLY **Row 65** Using Yarn E, K13, yo, K1, yo, K13. [29 sts]

Row 66 to 70 Using Yarn E, knit.

SIZES L, 1XL, AND 2XL ONLY **Row 71** Using Yarn C, K14, yo, K1, yo, K14. [31 sts]

Row 72 to 76 Using Yarn C, knit.

SIZES 1XL, AND 2XL ONLY **Row 77** Using Yarn A, K15, yo, K1, yo, K15. [33 sts]

Row 78 to 82 Using Yarn A, knit.

SIZE 2XL ONLY **Row 83** Using Yarn B, K16, yo, K1, yo, K16. [35 sts]

Row 84 to 88 Using Yarn B, knit.

Simply Knitting issue 214

Round neck cardigan

For the sleeve, Row 2 after changing to 4mm needles should read:

Row 2 Beg with st 5 (2: 4: 1) of Chart, patt 5 (2: 4: 1) st(s) to beg of Row 2 of Chart (st 1), work 10-st rep 4 (5: 5: 6) times, patt 6 (3: 5: 2) sts to end, ending with st 5 (8: 6: 9) of Chart.

Stitch of the month: Foxtail lace

Row 27 K1, (k2tog, yo) twice, K3, (yo, sl1, K1, pss0) twice, yo, K2.

Minty fresh two tone jumper

T3B should read: slip 1 st onto cn and hold at back of work, k2 then p st from cn.

Peacock Purse

The Back is misnumbered from row 15 onwards. Row 14 is numbered as row 15 etc etc. There is no missing row.

Sudoku

Row 5 K3, k2tog, yo, K1, yo, ssk, yo, sl1, K1, pss0, K3.

Simply Knitting issue 211

In the Beatrix Potter supplement that came with the print edition of the magazine, Jemima Puddleduck's beak, after "Work base of beak" the instructions should include this additional text:

First row: Inc in first st, k1. 3sts

Next row: Purl.

Next row: Inc in first st, knit to last st, inc. 5sts

Rep last 2 rows again. 7sts

Next row: Purl.

Cast off.

Row 16 should read: Using Yarn B K2, bring Yarn B to front of work, using Yarn A K1, using Yarn A P4, *using Yarn B P1, using Yarn A P6; rep from * to last 10 sts, using Yarn B P1, using Yarn A P6, using Yarn A K1, bring Yarn A to front of work, using Yarn B K2

Cat socks

The pattern should say 'work in st st' after 'change to yarn B' in the leg section.

Tumbling Blocks

Back should be worked to 40cm.

Cast on 9 sts using Yarn B and 2.75mm needles.

Row 1 Knit.

Row 2 Purl.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more.

Row 7 K1, k3tog, K1, k3tog, K1. [5 sts]

Row 8 Purl

Row 9 P1, p3tog, P1. [3 sts]

Row 16 K2, P9, K3.

There's a row numbering error in this pattern. It should read:

UPPER TROUSERS

Row 7 (RS joining row) Cast on 2 sts, K2 then K22 across second Leg, turn, cast on 6 sts, turn, with RS facing K22 sts of first Leg, turn, cast on 2 sts, turn. [54 sts]

Rows 8 to 10 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Row 11 K6, kfb, *K4, kfb; rep from * to last 7 sts, K7. [63 sts]

Rows 12 to 22 Starting on a WS purl row, work in st st.

Break Yarn N and change to Yarn E.

Rows 23 and 24 Knit.

Cast off.

Nordic Twist

There's a small correction for the Heart Chart. The key for the filled-in square should read "P on RS; K on WS".

Also on the Heart Chart, the half heart on the left-hand side of the chart on rows 22-26 needs to move down one row to match up with the half heart on the right.

Poinsettia brooch

After Row 9 of the Leaves, work the next row as follows:

S11, K1, pss0, K5, k2tog. [7 sts]

Purl 1 row, then work Rows 10-14 as printed.

Stitch of the Month: Woven Diamonds

Rows 9, 10, 19 and 20 should read as follows:

Row 9 Purl.

Row 10 Knit.

Row 19 Purl.

Row 20 Knit.

Peaceful Prairie

LEFT FRONT AND BACK PIECE

Rows 6, 8, 14, **16**, 22, 24, 30 and 32 (WS) Work Edging Chart B, purl to last 9 sts, work Edging Chart A. (*In printed pattern there's no Row 16*)

SLEEVE

At the end of the Sleeve, the round numbering should read as follows:

Change to 4mm DPNs.

Work cuff pattern as follows:

Round 1 Knit.

Round 2 Purl.

Rep last 2 rounds once more.

Rounds 5 and 6 Knit.

Round 7 (K2tog, yo) to end of round.

Rounds 8 and 9 Knit.

Round 10 Purl.

Round 11 Knit.

Round 12 Purl.

Little Rosemary

For Back and both Fronts, the lace pattern should be worked until the piece measures 10 (13: 15: 18: **20**)cm, ending with a RS row.

The neck shaping for the Left and Right Fronts should be worked as follows:

LEFT FRONT SHAPE NECK Next row (WS) Cast off **6 (7: 8: 7: 9)** sts, purl to end. [**4 (4: 4: 6: 6)** sts]

SIZES 2-3YRS AND 4-5YRS ONLY Next row (RS) K1, k2tog, knit to last 5 sts, k2tog, K3. [- (-: -: **4: 4**) sts] Next row (WS) **Purl** to end.

ALL SIZES Next row (RS) **K3tog, K1.** [2 sts] Next row (WS) **P2tog and fasten off.**

RIGHT FRONT SHAPE NECK Next row (RS) Cast off 6 (7: 8: 7: 9) sts, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, K1. [4 (4: 4: 6: 6) sts]

SIZES 2-3YRS AND 4-5YRS ONLY Next row (WS) **P2tog, P4.** [- (-: -: 5: 5) sts] Next row (RS) **K2tog, K3.** [- (-: -: 4: 4) sts]

ALL SIZES Next row (WS) **P3tog, P1.** [2 sts] Next row (RS) **K2tog** and fasten off.
